

Referral guidance

- Referral mechanism is important
- SBAR
- Consultant to consultant referrals are ideal
 - Most senior available clinician
 - Referrals should not be delegated
- Clear involvement of patient/advocate
 - Information leaflet
- Clear recommendation: what is being asked for?
- Document referral to whom and when
- Use the form





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Patient and family support

- Help families understand and participate in decision-making
- Help to gather "right" input into decision-making
- Information leaflet
 - Patient
 - family and friends





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
- Transparent
- Consistent
- Defensible
- Based on relevant evidence
 - Clinical details, capacity to benefit, patients values/wishes
- Reasoning
 - Promote "type 2" decision-making
 - Cognitive de-biasing
- Recommended treatment
 - Not just admission (before resources)
- Implementation

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Implementation study: support
