Entry Requirements	<p><b>Academic Qualifications</b> To apply, you should have, or be predicted to gain, a minimum of an upper second class honours (2:1) degree (or overseas equivalent) in any subject. Candidates with a lower second class degree should hold either a Master's or a Doctoral qualification to be considered for entry to the MB ChB.</p> <p><b>Work experience</b> All applicants must have completed two weeks' (70 hours') full-time work experience across a minimum of two placements in the last three years.</p> <p><b>United Kingdom Clinical Aptitude Test (UCAT)</b> All applicants must take the University Clinical Aptitude Test (UCAT) or, if appropriate, the UCATSEN.
