Thrive is a new women's in-person development programme designed to help women students grow in confidence and develop their resilience and sense of agency. If you sign up, you can also work with a mentor to support you through your personal development journey. A flexible offer is available during 2023-24: a two-day programme, and an alternative version of content delivery over four afternoons.

Thrive is open to both undergraduate and postgraduate women students, studying any subject. Students must identify as a woman or non-binary person comfortable in a female-centred community. Places are limited to just 30 per programme, so advance sign up is advised. [See dates and sign up](#)
