IATL Module Registration 2024-25 - What you need to know.

1. Check if need authorisation from your home department. We have a general list on our registration page.

2. Complete our online application form.

To do this, log in with your university IT account (You will not be able to complete the form unless you are logged in first)

3. Register for the module.

We will get back to you in early June to confirm whether you have been allocated a place.

Once you receive this, you will be able to register for the module officially, following your home department's procedure once they open module registration.

Frequently asked questions:

My home department needs to authorise my application. How do I do this?

- Authorisation required: please reply to the email acknowledgement you receive after completing the request form, copying in the person/people listed for your department and asking them to reply all with their authorisation.
- No authorisation required: you do not need to do anything beyond submitting your request, at this stage.
- If you require a signature for an Unusual Options form, email us at IATL.modules@warwick.ac.uk
- If your department is not listed on our webpage, reply to the email acknowledgement you receive after completing the request form, copying in your Personal Tutor OR Director of Undergraduate Studies OR Departmental Administrator (as seems appropriate in your home department), and ask them to reply all with their authorisation.

Each module has 2 codes. Which code should I use?

- If you will be going into your intermediate year in 2024-25, (level 5), then use the code that begins ILOxx
- If you will be studying at level 6 in 2023-24, then use the code that begins IL1xx

My home department needs me to register for my modules in the spring/summer term 2024. Is this ok?

You can select the module if it is included as one of your options but be aware that this does not guarantee your place. You will still need to complete our online application form. Your place will only be guaranteed once we have confirmed it with you.

The module is full. Can I join a waiting list?

Yes, you can join the waiting list. If a place becomes available, you will be contacted.
