

Business and Management Modules for Warwick Undergraduate Students 2022-23

If you're a Warwick undergraduate student interested in taking Business and Management modules in 2022-23, the module table below provides an overview of key foundational business and management modules that you can take in Warwick Business School (WBS). These are designed to allow you to access foundation level business learning on a range of the most popular business topics.

If you are in the second year of Physics with Business Studies you must take one of these modules foundational modules.

Foundation modules - what you can study when

These modules are for undergraduate students only:

- IB2 modules can be taken by students in either their second or final year of their degree.

Important:

- You are very welcome to study a range of these foundational level modules in different disciplines (e.g. you could study IB2MKT Marketing in Practice in your second year, and IB2AIP Accounting in Practice in your final year)
- If you are entering your final year and have never taken a WBS module before it is possible to take foundational modules (at IB2 level) in your final year.

Advanced modules

A wider range of advanced WBS modules are also available. Further information will be published on my.wbs.

A number of these modules have pre-requisites where prior study in the subject is required. It is likely that, from 2023-24, all of these modules will need you to have taken the foundational level module (from the list above) in the business area you wish to take advanced module study in. If you will be taking intermediate level (year 2) study in 2022-23 it is important that you consider this and plan your study accordingly.

Important Action You Must Take

- These modules are offered to all Warwick undergraduate students. Check with your home department about any rules or requirements for taking modules outside your department and where they are allowed in your course structure.
- For information, and to apply to WBS modules, you must have a my.wbs account. Go to my.wbs.ac.uk/registration and use your University number (excluding the 'u') and IT password to create an account.
- To secure a place on a WBS module you must do BOTH of the following:
 - Apply for the module using my.wbs (see below)
 - AND
 - Register the module with your department / on University systems (usually eVision but check with your department)
- If you decide not to study a module in WBS you must ensure you update both on my.wbs (or email our team, details below) and your department.
