Case	Problem solving provides undergraduates the core skills to apply their learned knowledge to practical issues. General problem-solving principles can be taught from the front of a lecture space at 2m distancing, however physics requires students to work through problems themselves to consolidate the material and this requires in-person support. During these problem-solving tutoring sessions, there will be occasions when the Tutoring staff may need to support individual students with their work by inspecting the student's solutions in their worksheets at their desks, occasionally at a '1m Plus' separation, with appropriate control measures in place. These occasional instances will arise only when the Tutor is unable to offer adequate support to a student from the front of room. Class sizes range from 5 to 25 students and are held in flat teaching spaces. All rooms have 2m separation of attendees and require all participants to wear a face covering. The additional control measures will be detailed in the associated risk assessment.
