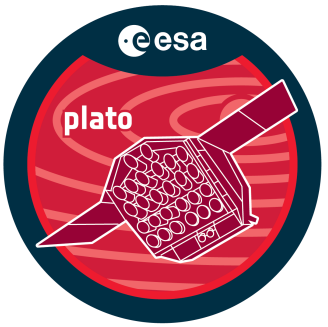




Different options for getting involved

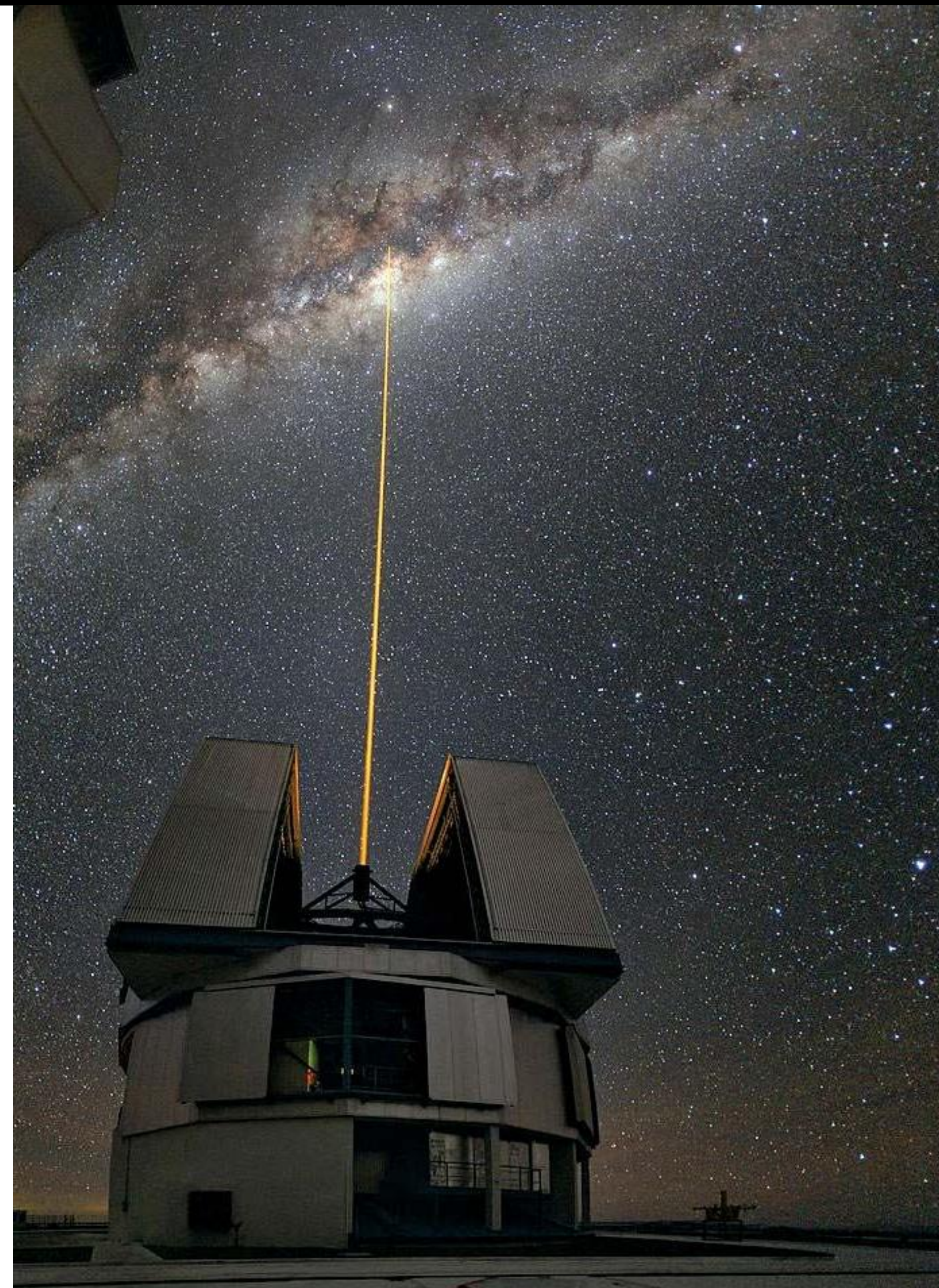
- There are multiple ways to get involved in PLATO
 - Use our data
 - Guest Observer proposals
 - Contribute to the GOP
 - Join the PMC





Contribute to the GOP

- Register your facility (telescope + instrument) as part of the follow-up network.
 - Procedure still being defined and set up.
- Register as an observer from the PMC.
- Be an 'external contributor'.
 - There will be an interface for anyone to upload observations that they think would be beneficial and that they're willing to share.
 - Data will go through quality control.





Joining the PMC

- Do you want to contribute to the Science Management (PSM), Data Centre (PDC), or both?
- Look through the organisation charts:
 - Find work packages that you could contribute to
 - Contact the work package leader(s) to discuss your contribution
- Once agreed:
 - Contact the PSM Office or PDC Office to ask for the membership & NDA form
 - Follow the instruction on the form!
- If you think there's a gap in the PSM you could fill, contact the PSM Office to discuss it.
