

Enthusiastic Health Psychologists Wanted

Are you looking for additional clinical training and practical experience?

An exciting opportunity has arisen to work with a multidisciplinary research team at Warwick University on an intervention study funded by the National Institute for Health Research (NIHR).

The study aims to evaluate the feasibility of a novel intervention for chronic pain patients with comorbid insomnia in primary care settings.

We are looking for 6 trial therapists to deliver the intervention over several months in early 2016. This role will involve approximately 32 hours of patient contact for each therapist. The successful applicants will undergo 2-4 weeks of intensive training and will have access to regular supervision from 3 HCPC registered health/clinical psychologists on our team. You will also have the opportunity to take part in other research activities such as helping to develop patient treatment manuals.

This post will be ideal for applicants completing the British Psychological Society Stage 2 Health Psychology Training.

You must be willing to travel to primary care settings to deliver the intervention at the patients own GP surgeries (within the Coventry and Warwickshire area).

You will be paid the standard NHS Health Psychologist hourly rate for the time you spent on treatment delivery.
