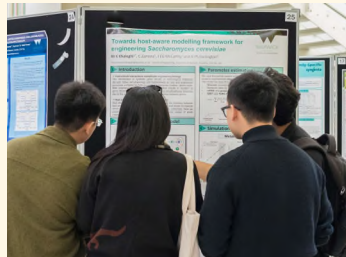


FSEM 2026 - Call For Papers

Technical paper submissions are invited on **any topic** within the scope of FSEM.

Submission limit of 3 papers for each author.

Author must present at symposium (registration is free).
