

Battery Safety UK 2026 - Privacy Notice

The University of Warwick is the data controller for the personal data processed in connection with obtaining payment and administering attendance for the Battery Safety UK 2026 event taking place on 6 May 2026 and administered by WMG, University of Warwick.

When you register and/or purchase a ticket for the event, we will collect:

- First and last name
- Email address
- Company/institution name and postcode
- Position/role
- Sector
- Payment details
- Dietary requirements
- Accessibility requirements
- Marketing consent preferences

This information is collected so that we can process your booking, take payment, communicate with you about the event, and make any necessary arrangements relating to catering or accessibility. Our lawful basis for this processing is the performance of a contract with you, and in some cases the performance of a task in the public interest in connection with the University's research and education functions.

Your data will be shared with relevant University of Warwick staff involved in organising or supporting the event, as well as with our contracted payment provider for payment processing. We may also share a list of attendee names only with the event sponsor, the Faraday Institution, where required; no contact details or special category data will be shared. Your information will not be sold or shared with any other third parties unless required by law. Internally, your data may also be shared with University finance and administrative staff where necessary for lawful payment processing, including via BACS or international transfer services.

We will retain your event administration data for up to two years after the event to allow us to evaluate the event, respond to follow-up queries, and contact previous attendees about future iterations. If you have consented to receive marketing communications, we will continue to hold your data for this purpose until you withdraw your consent, which you may do at any time. Any special category data you provide, such as dietary or accessibility information, will be deleted within three months after the event.
