

Education Studies Department Winston Scholarship

Deadline 9 June 2024 12 midnight (GMT)

Award: The award will contribute £10,000 towards tuition fees (£5,000 for home students and £10,000 for overseas students) and is available to all eligible students.

Eligibility: To be eligible for an award, applicants must be starting the MA Drama and Theatre Education in October 2024. Candidates are required to have applied to the programme by 9 June 2024.

Application process: You will need to complete a scholarship application online form [here](#). . Please spend some time answering each of the questions in the application form as the information you provide will be carefully considered by the committee reviewing scholarship applications.

You should ensure that all the documents required to make a decision on the Master's application have been uploaded to your application portal by the date of the scholarship application deadline (personal statement, transcript, academic reference).

Award process: The Scholarship Selection Committee will shortlist candidates based on the case for support.

The scholarship(s) will be deducted from the successful candidate's academic fees for the year(s) of study at the University of Warwick. As part of the award, the successful applicants will need to provide a short report with feedback and the impact this scholarship has made to their lives and careers.

If a scholarship winner fails to register at Warwick or is in any event deregistered from Warwick within the academic year, Warwick may award the scholarship to another candidate.

Individual feedback to applicants will not be given.

Deadline: 9 June 2024. Applications with missing or late documentation will not be considered for this award.
