Guidance for non-UK nationals

Do I require a Student Visa?

If you are from outside Europe (EEA and Switzerland), or, from Europe but not eligible for [the EU Settlement Scheme](#), you may require a visa to study in the UK.

If you already hold a valid Student Visa (including Tier 4 visa) at the time of application you may be eligible for the [Graduate Visa Route](#)

If you are an Irish Citizen you do not need to apply for a visa or hold settled status under the EU Settlement Scheme.

What fees will I pay?

- If you are an Irish national or hold settled or pre-settled status, your fee will be that stated for Home students.
- The current fee for Home students is £9250*

**Please note that you may be asked to complete a fees questionnaire to confirm your eligibility for Home fees. The course fee cannot be amended once you have enrolled for the course and therefore, you must complete this questionnaire prior to enrolment.*

- If you are from outside Europe (EEA and Switzerland), or, from Europe but not eligible for the EU Settlement Scheme you will be required to pay International Student Fees.
- The current fee for international students is £21,060.

Guidance for non-UK nationals

Am I eligible for financial support?

If you're starting a course on or after 1 August 2021, you must have [settled or pre-settled status](#) under the EU Settlement Scheme to be eligible for student finance. Irish citizens are also eligible for student finance.

If you are eligible for student finance support you may also apply for a bursary, where available.

If you are from outside Europe (EEA and Switzerland), or, from Europe but not eligible for the EU Settlement Scheme you will NOT be eligible for tuition fee funding. You will also not be eligible for any bursaries or scholarships.
