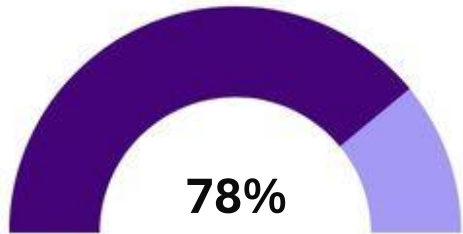


Graduate Destinations

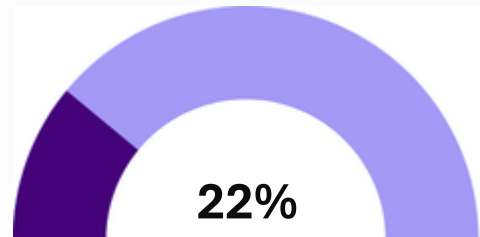
In **2023-24**, the Department of Economics had **713 final year graduates** across our four-degree programmes:

- BSc/BA Economics, Politics and International Studies

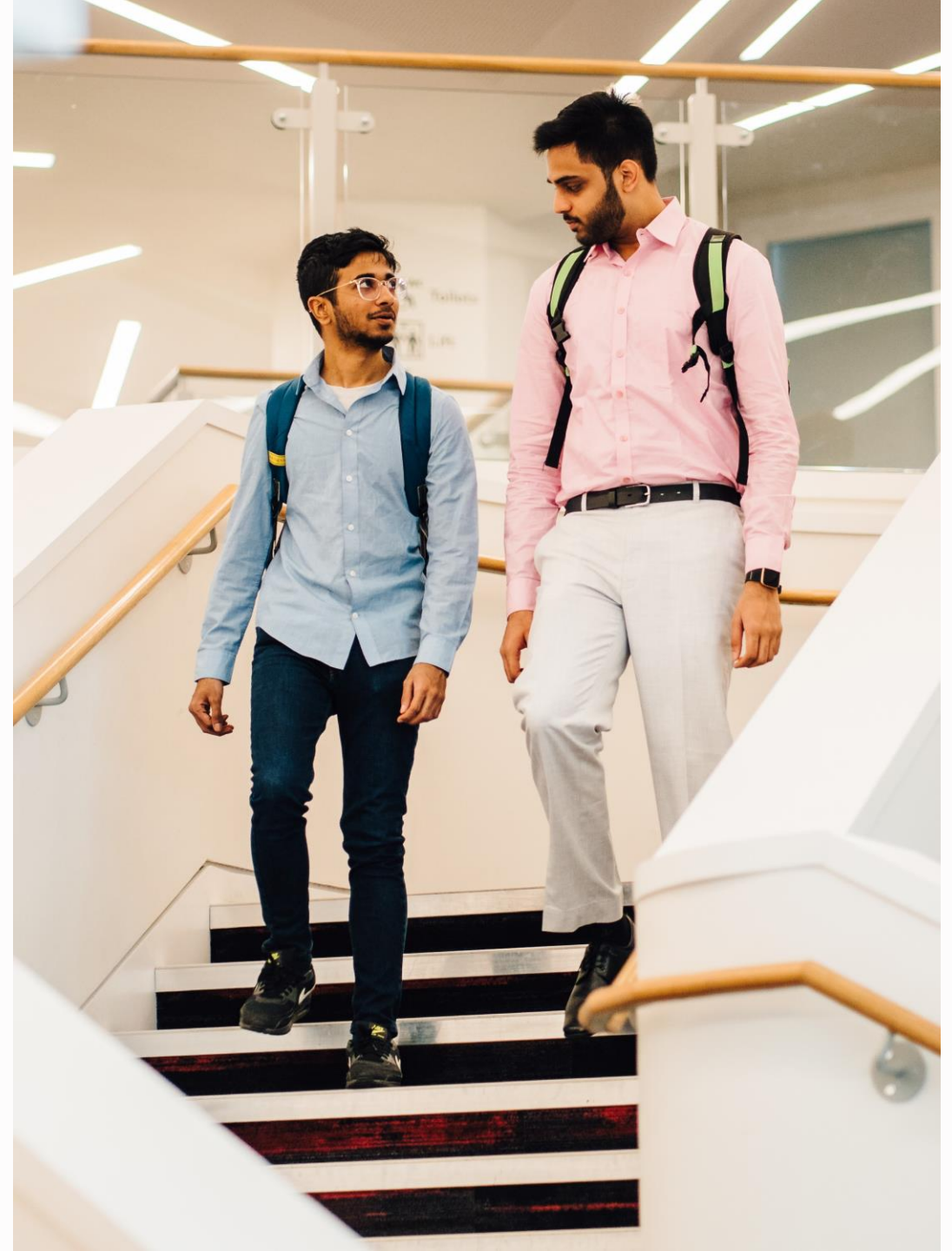
Following graduation in July 2024, **383 (54%)** of our graduates responded to our departmental destinations survey, of which:

Asia: 11.1%

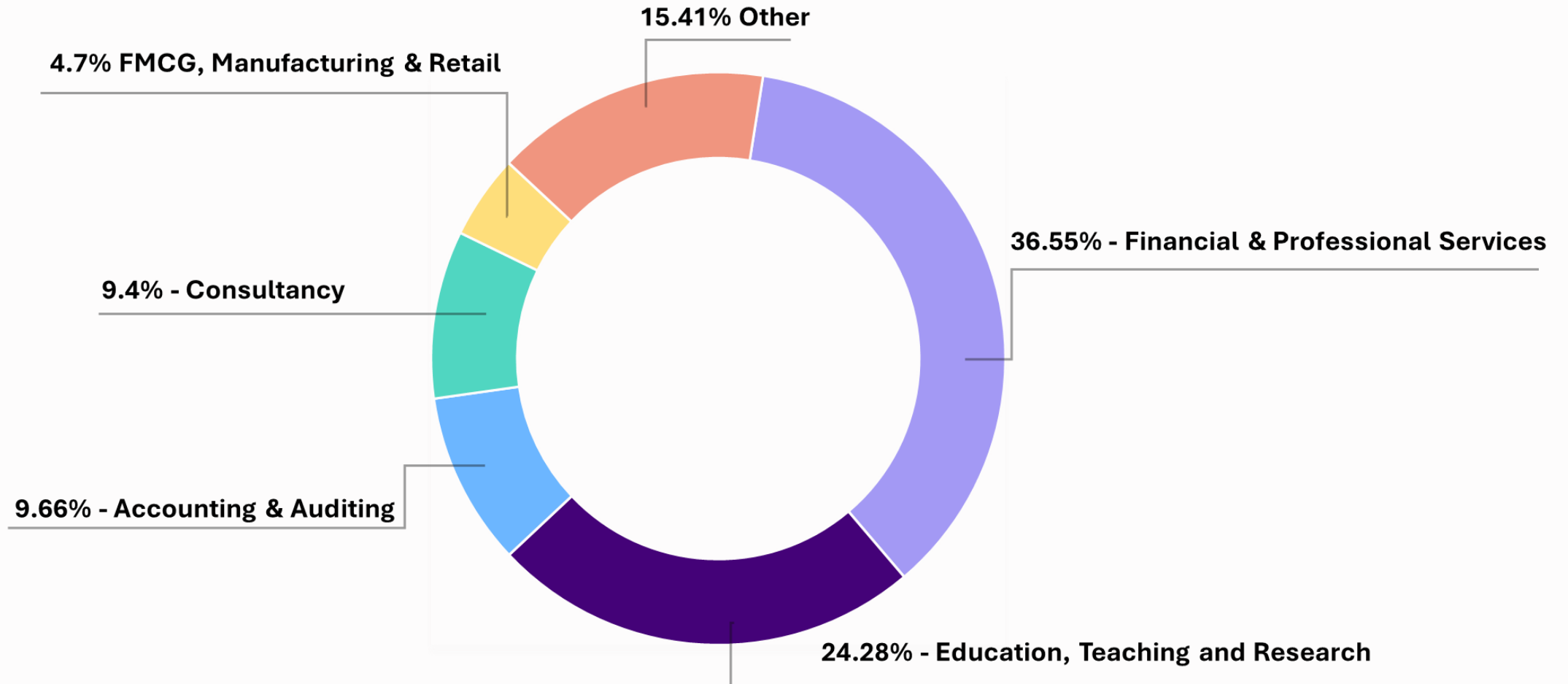
Rest of Europe: 2.9%

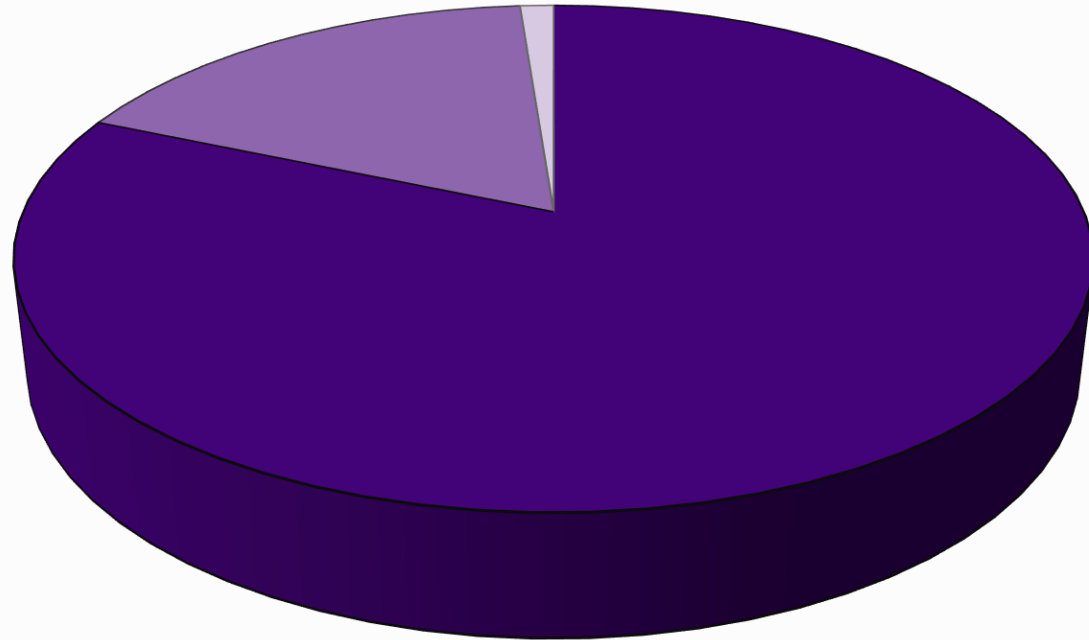
