Extraordinary circumstances which are beyond your control, which may have an effect on your mental health or your academic performance. Then I'm the person to get in touch with and, and I'm usually based in room S 2.140 in the social sciences building. But you can also e-mail me and we can set up a meeting either in person or online, whichever is more suitable, the details of my contacts and emails and how to. I also hold a weekly drop in sessions.

For which are called academic and

pastoral support, drop in sessions.

This is when you do not have

to make an appointment,

but you can just drop in.

Either they're gonna be held in person or

they will sometimes be held online as well.

You can just drop in and we can

have an informal chat about any

issues that you may be facing.

So I hope you take full advantage of

the pastoral support system that we have

at the department and at the university.
