Throughout term 1 we will have 3 networking sessions specifically designed for Postgraduate Taught students which will take place in the Postgrad Hub.







Microsoft OneNote is an easy-to-use note-taking programme that allows you to make notes and capture text, images, video and sound from a variety of sources including the internet and e-mail.


#### Microsoft 365 Productivity Tools – 25<sup>th</sup> of October 3-4pm
