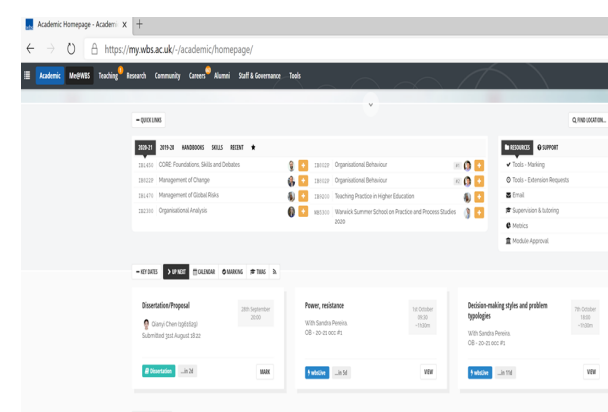

My.wbs is the online managed learning environment of Warwick Business School. During your time at WBS, my.wbs will be used to provide you with information about:

1. your programme and course of study,

5. deliver lecture and seminar notes
6. Is the means to submit assignments electronically (for some courses)

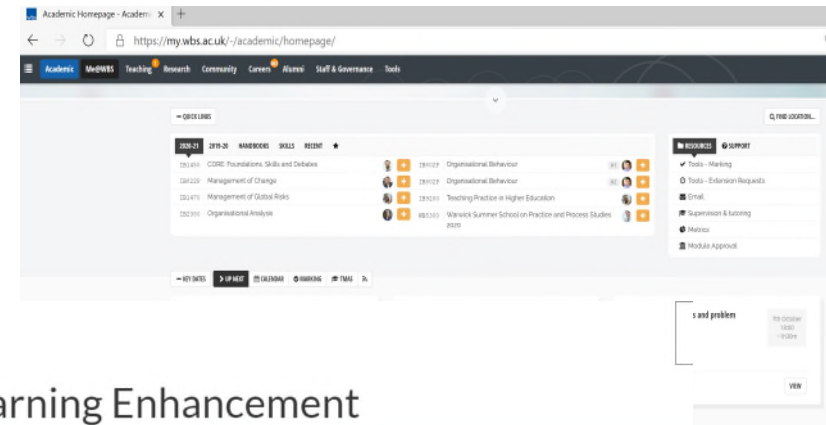
## my.wbs
