What is The Warwick Award?

- A programme for recognising Core Skills development through your experiences while a student at Warwick
- A process of reflective practice on those experiences
- A portfolio of activity and reflections recorded on your personal profile that you can keep after you graduate
- Evidence of transferable skills from your course, student life, and other personal experiences
- A way of recording examples of skills in action for your employability, career, and personal development
- An official digital certificate and digital badge from the University of Warwick, proving you have practised these skills



The Warwick Award is hosted on a digital platform called Gradintelligence. Your Gradintelligence account is created automatically for you shortly after you enrol on your course. You received an email from Gradintelligence to your University email address asking you to ‘activate’ your account at this time.

If you have not yet activated your account or agreed to take part in the Award, , please check your student email inbox for the activation email from Gradintelligence, sent to you shortly after you registered as a student at Warwick. Search for ‘gradintelligence’, click on the unique link in the email and follow the instructions. Make sure you use your Warwick student email address to set up the account.

If you are having *any* problems accessing your account, please use [the account recovery option](#) by clicking on the link entitled ‘I can’t log in’.






