

Submission Guidelines

Please submit an **extended abstract** of **strictly no more than 3 pages (references excluded)**. Abstracts can contain figures and tables - within the 3-page limit with at least one-inch margins and font-size of no less than 11.

The abstract should clearly outline the contribution, methodology, data (if the paper has an empirical section) and key findings/results of the paper. <u>Please</u> <u>ensure that the abstract does not contain your name, institution, or any other</u> <u>identifying information.</u> Failure to comply with the requirements will result in your submission being automatically rejected. Single and co-authored papers are welcome, excluding papers co-authored with professors.

Please specify whether you would like your project to be considered for the presentation session (20 minutes), for the flash session (5 minutes) or for both. Presenters are additionally expected to serve as discussants for a fellow presenter's paper, according to their field of research. We will always prioritise allocating a slot in the presentation session if both options are selected. We will compensate travel and accommodation costs for accepted participants.

The **deadline** for submission is <u>**31**st</u> January, <u>2024 (Midnight GMT)</u></u>, but we strongly encourage early submissions. We kindly ask each applicant to submit **only one application** under their name: if multiple abstracts are submitted by the same author, only the earliest application will be evaluated. Applicants will be notified on the application outcome via email **by mid March**
