


Figure 3.1 Rule of law vs. per capita GDP





A 1948 reproduction of the Stradanus engraving, a 17th-century certificate for indulgences, in return for cash contributions to build a shrine.




Figure 4.4 Ruler duration in Western Europe and the Islamic world




Figure 2: Proportion Scientist and Madrasa-Affiliated by Time Since First Madrasa
