



## **Important: Review of Assessment Methods**

During the 2025/26 academic year, the Law School is undertaking a review of its module assessment methods. As a result, the assessment methods currently stated for optional and core modules are subject to change from the start of the 26/27 academic year.

Our assessment review will consider a greater variety of assessment methods, including the potential introduction of more oral assessments (presentations, moots, negotiations, or vivas), multiple choice tests, portfolios and other methods. We will also seek to spread out assessment deadlines where possible.

Where exams are retained as an assessment method for a module, they may change to in-person examinations. However, for some modules, the current assessment method will remain as is.

Any changes to module assessment methods would take effect from the start of the 26/27 academic year. Students choosing their options for 26/27 will be given clear information about the assessment methods for each module ahead of making their module choices.
