I am writing to remind you of the Examination Preparation Briefing on 6<sup>th</sup> May in RO.21, at 9.30am. Daniel, Sukh and I will be offering tips for you on how to approach and prepare for examinations, going through the rules and showing you the WAS Trial Assessment which introduces the WAS online platform we use for examinations. The examination briefing will be recorded and uploaded if you can't attend on Wednesday.

### WAS Trial Assessment

The Trial Assessment is not another exam, it is just an opportunity to familiarise yourself with the platform. Ahead of your examination(s) in the Warwick Assessment System (WAS), a set of trial assessments will be set up to give you experience of using the system.

It is not compulsory that you take this trial assessments, and it is not marked or with department-specific questions, but it is strongly recommended that you take it to ensure you are familiar with the system before you take your formal exams. Feedback shows that students experience less difficulty, lower anxiety, and fewer problems when they have used the platform in advance of their formal exams.
