Your degree results arrive tomorrow. Individual assessment results are scheduled for release on Tabula at around 10am. You should receive formal notification of your degree classification from the University shortly afterwards but note that the University has to release results in batches so please be patient and don't panic if they don't arrive at 10 on the dot. They are definitely coming. I am aiming to release the Prize-winner letters at around 11am tomorrow.

Note that **examination feedback** is not released with the results - all **WAS** feedback is released with the Intermediate feedback on 17 July 2026.

The University notification will tell you if you have further assessments to complete. If you are unsuccessful in a Module assessment, you will receive a letter from the Law School on 10th July with details of your resit assignments. In some cases this letter will offer you a choice as to whether to carry your fail (with an impact on your overall mark) and graduate this summer or take an optional resit. This option cannot be offered to students who have not passed or completed their Supervised Project as this is a core module. If you are in this position, please discuss this important decision with your Personal Tutor or get in touch with either Daniel or I.
