I hope this finds everyone well.

This is just a short note to let you know two important things:

1. That the form that you need to complete if you are in your First, Second or Third year (or PT equivalent) in preparation for your Upgrade/Progress Review is now live. It can be accessed here: [PGR Progress Review Form](#). The form needs to be completed by 22nd May, 2026.

Please familiarise yourself with the form and allow plenty of time to complete it. This should not be left to the last minute as it covers a lot of ground. In aid of this, we have introduced a “save for later” feature so that you can fill it in at a pace that works for you.

Please also note that in one part of the form, you are asked to note milestones for the next 12 months that you have agreed with your supervisor(s). It would be a good idea to dedicate some time to this in your next supervision meeting, or some other time in the next couple of weeks.

2. As noted in my previous message (Subject: ‘PGR Formal Progression Reviews’ on 17 March), I will be running a follow-up session on Progression Reviews at the PGR Workshop on Monday 27th April. In that session, I will walk you through the new form, what to expect in the review meeting, and answer any questions you may have. Please make sure you attend.
