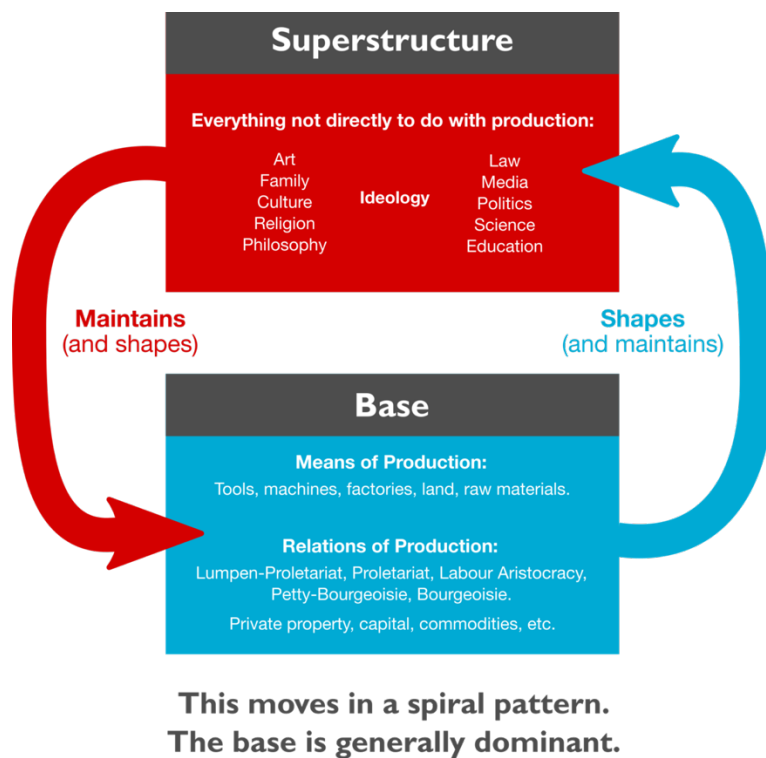

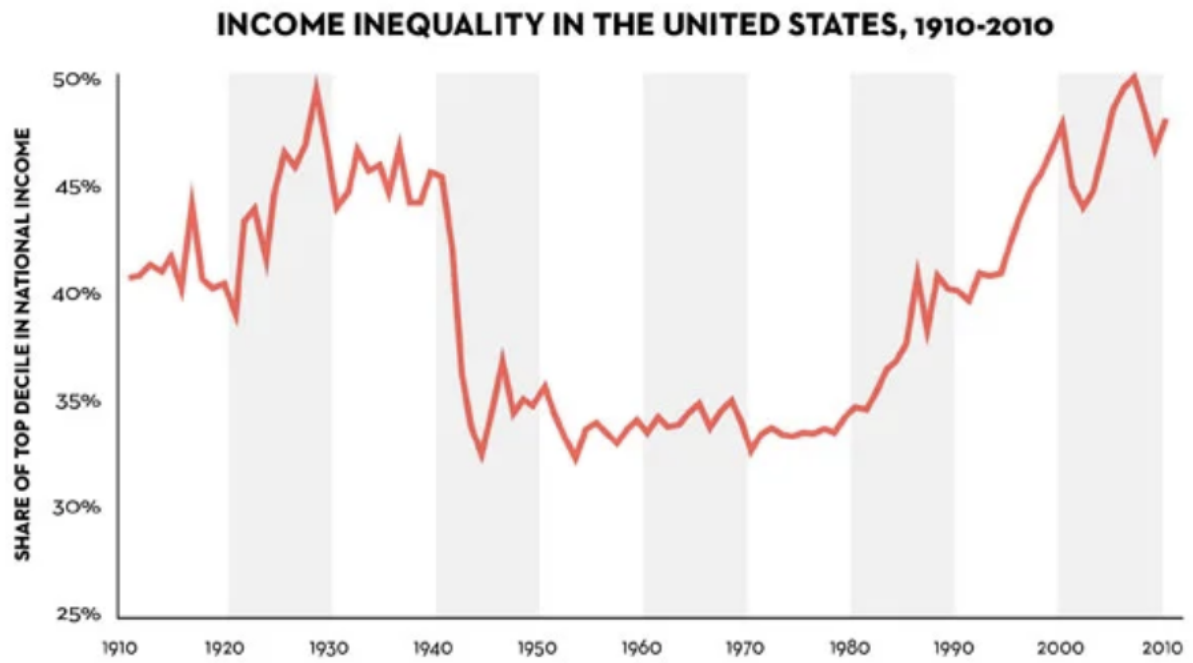
- “Relations of production constitutes the economic structure of society, the real foundation on which rises a legal and political superstructure”
