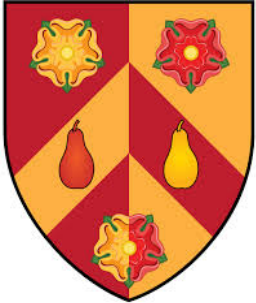


ROBIN GANDY

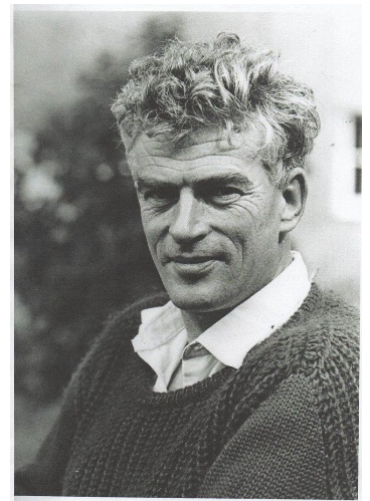
