Errors in the notes in *Popper Selections* and some of its translations

The endnotes on pp. 379-461 of *Popper Selections* contain a number of seriously misleading page references to other books by Karl Popper. In 2002–2003 Routledge issued new impressions of *Conjectures and Refutations*, *The Logic of Scientific Discovery*, *The Open Society and Its Enemies*, *The Poverty of Historicism*, and *Unended Quest*, in the series of ROUTLEDGE CLASSICS. The pagination in these new volumes is different from that of their predecessors, so that countless page references that had been made to the books in the previous philosophical literature and elsewhere have been systematically disabled. Routledge was warned in advance of the inevitable effect of what they intended to do, but elected to disregard the warning.

The table overleaf replaces by chapter & section references all the page references in the endnotes in *Popper Selections* that point to other books by Popper, even those (references to *Objective Knowledge* and to *The Self and Its Brain*) that are unaffected by the supersession of the original Routledge editions by the Classics editions. Some of the new references are a little less specific than the old ones, but they should be easy enough to follow.

Readers of *Popper Selections* in translation may find the new references to be of some rather overdue assistance in locating, in existing translations of Popper's other books, the passages referred to in the notes in the anthology.
