Assessment - Competencies

Communicating with impact	Students speak clearly and professional at all times, and are listened to by peers. Students also listen to others' suggestions and consider them carefully when making decisions. Students consistently make eye contact and present positive body language at all times, by smiling and standing open. Students present themselves in an engaging manner.
Professional ethics/behaviours	Students act in a professional manner at all times (appearance and attitude).
Commercial awareness	A demonstration of an understanding of how an organisation operations and strategic/operational initiatives. Responded positively to questions asked by assessors and acted well under pressure.
Resilience and tenacity	Students react positively to setbacks and develop strategies to deal with interruptions or adverse events. Interruptions or adverse events could involve dealing with internal conflict in their own teams.
Work effectively in diverse teams	Students work well together and build relationships to complete the task to the best of their ability.
Innovation and Creativity	Students think 'outside the box' when coming up with ideas, they demonstrate an ability to try and think of doing something that may not have been done before.

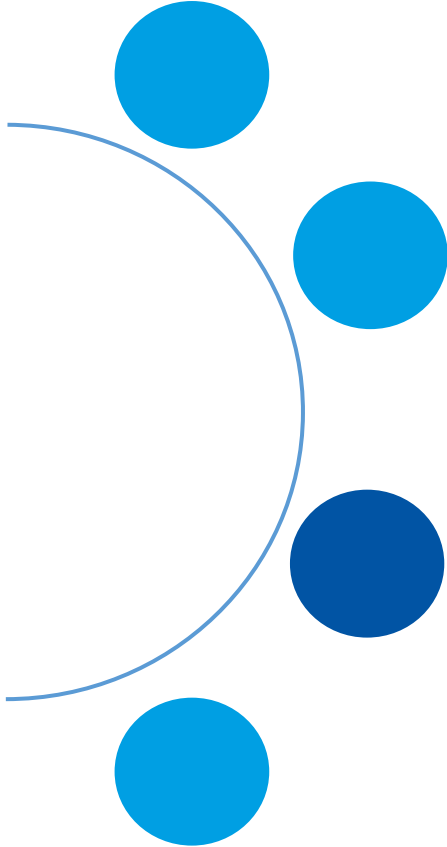


How to prepare

FOLLOW UP


Follow up with the people you connected with



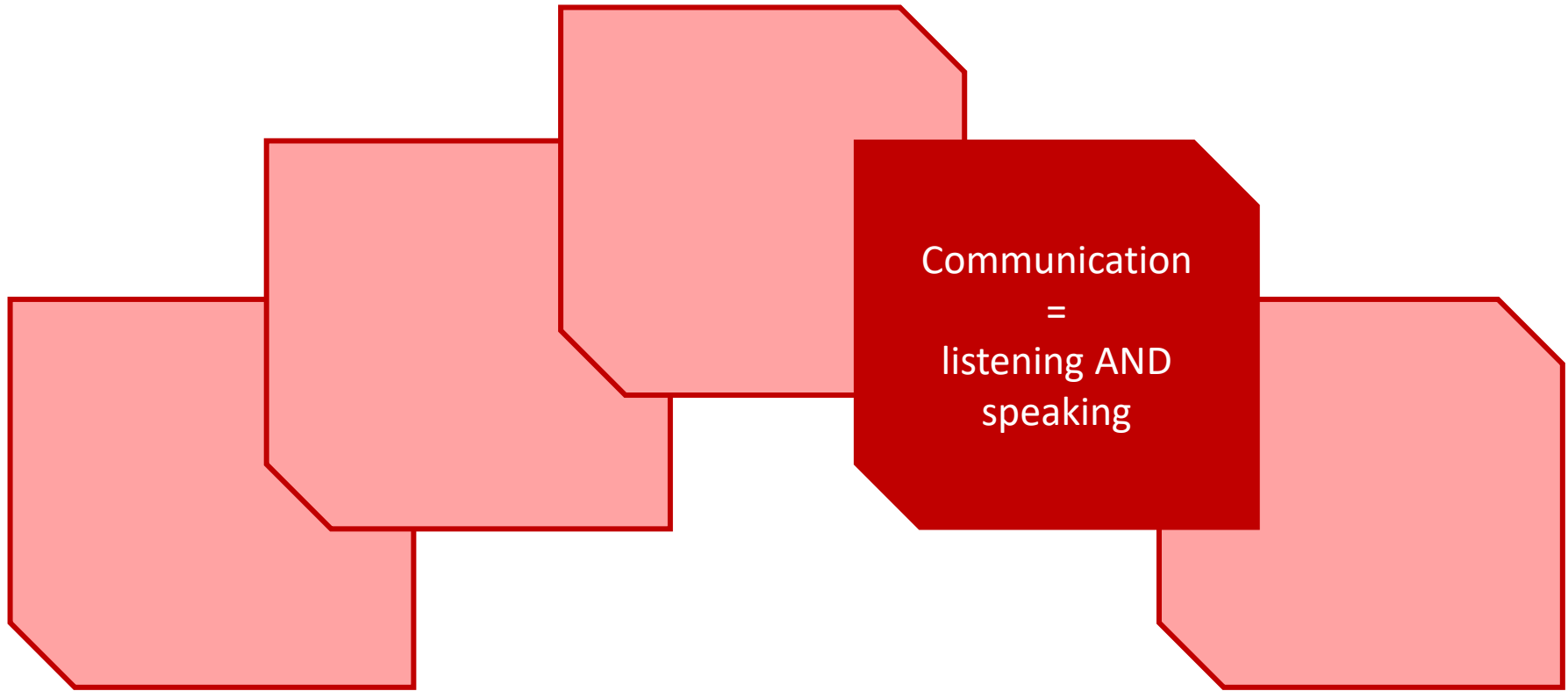

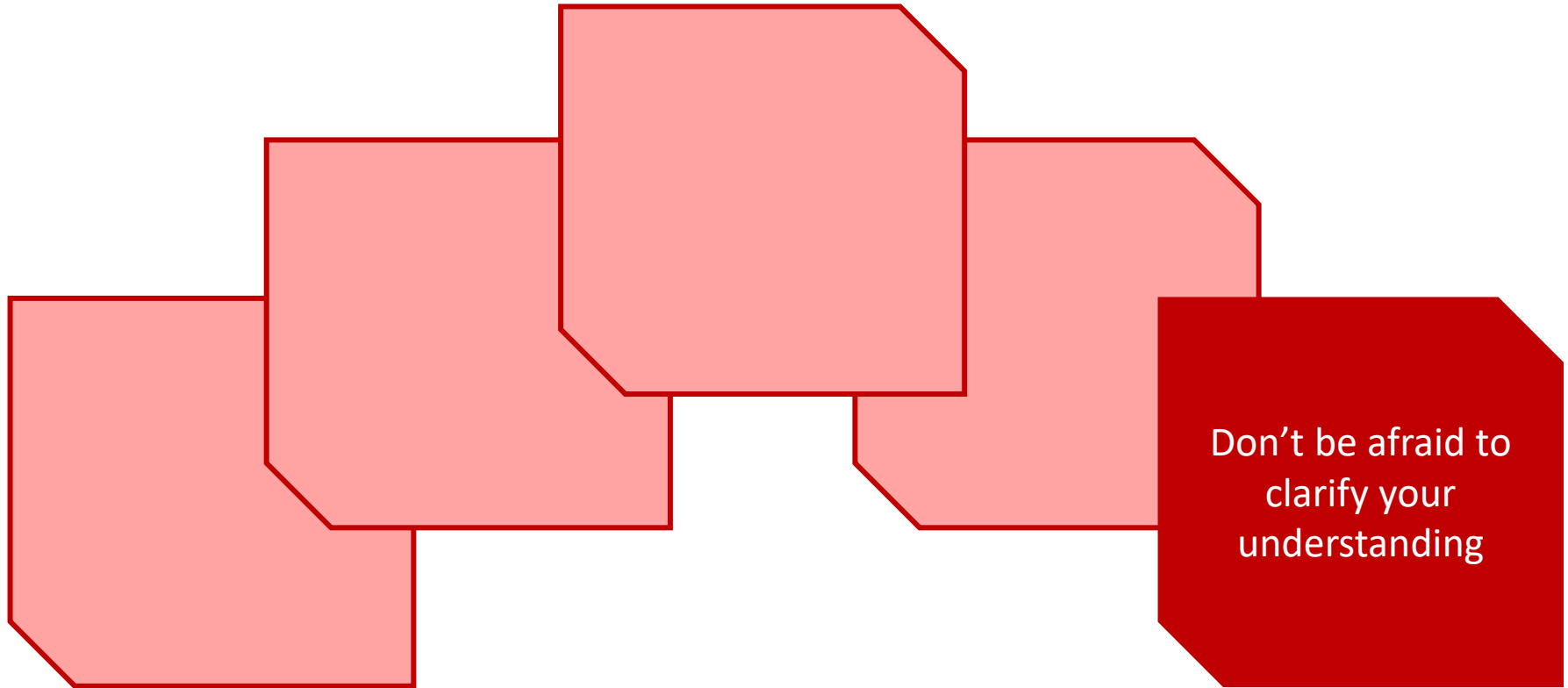
