

Throughout you will hear from a range of careers experts and practitioners who have developed the content you will explore and signpost you to other resources and activities.



Mentoring Tips

- Bookmark Mentee Resources (see next page for list but especially Mentee Online Area)
- Before each session, ask yourself "What do I want to get out of this session" (outcome/objectives)
- If it helps, download and use the Outcome / Objectives document (Mentee Online Area)
- Incorporate feedback at each session ... "Today helped me to ..." or "Ask each other, what one thing have you taken from today"
- Write up a reflection following each session, as a running diary. Be as brief or as detailed you like.
- Consider sending a session summary to your mentor on the key items and/or outcomes/actions;
 - it helps to ensure nothing is misunderstood
 - it holds you more accountable
 - typically helps you to remain focussed.
