Second Meeting | Tuesday 12 December **Reverse Engineering Ethnographic Texts**

In the second meeting we will use 'reverse engineering' to explore multiple ways to 'write up' ethnographic findings. We invite participants to bring ethnographic texts (either written by them or others) which they find compelling and to identify how data is presented in these works. We are particularly interested in understanding what kind of data is presented and how it is structured in the text. Our goal is to explore the different 'formats' that ethnographers use to present their findings so we can enrich our own writing toolkit.
