Each summer school we consider an advanced theme in practice and process studies. This year, we will discuss the impact of emerging "intelligent" technologies on organizational practices and processes together with **Samer Faraj** and **David K Allen**. **Samer Faraj** holds the Canada Research Chair in Technology, Innovation & Organizing at McGill University. His work spans innovation management, organizational theory, and healthcare management.

**David K Allen** is a Professor of Information Management at Leeds University. He focuses on information management practices and the influence of technology on organizational work.
