

## Electives – Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Am I able to take additional electives?

Unfortunately, the degree regulations do not allow you to take additional elective modules.

Is it possible to take an elective that is not on the list of electives for my course?

Unfortunately, the degree regulations do not allow you to take electives from other courses.

I am unable to log into the website to choose my elective module(s).

You must use your University login details, beginning u(ID number.....) and your password.

Am I likely to get a place on my preferred elective(s) or is there a limit on numbers?

We aim to allocate you to your preferred elective(s) wherever possible. If there are any timetable clashes/capacity issues, we may need to allocate you to a different elective module.

Are places allocated on a first-come first-served basis?

Allocation to electives is **not done** on a first-come first-served basis so there is no rush to submit your choices. Please take some time to read and digest all of the information provided, to determine what the best options are for you.

Will all elective modules listed run in 2025-26?

For a WBS module to run, we generally require a minimum number of students to be registered to it. As such, if we don't have enough students registered for a particular module, the elective may not run. In this case, students would be contacted and asked to make an alternative elective choice.

I submitted my elective choices incorrectly. Am I able to make changes?

You can log in and amend your choices any time before the stipulated deadline.

Is it possible to swap modules at the beginning of Term 3?

Unfortunately, once you have made your elective choices you **will not** be able to swap to another module.
