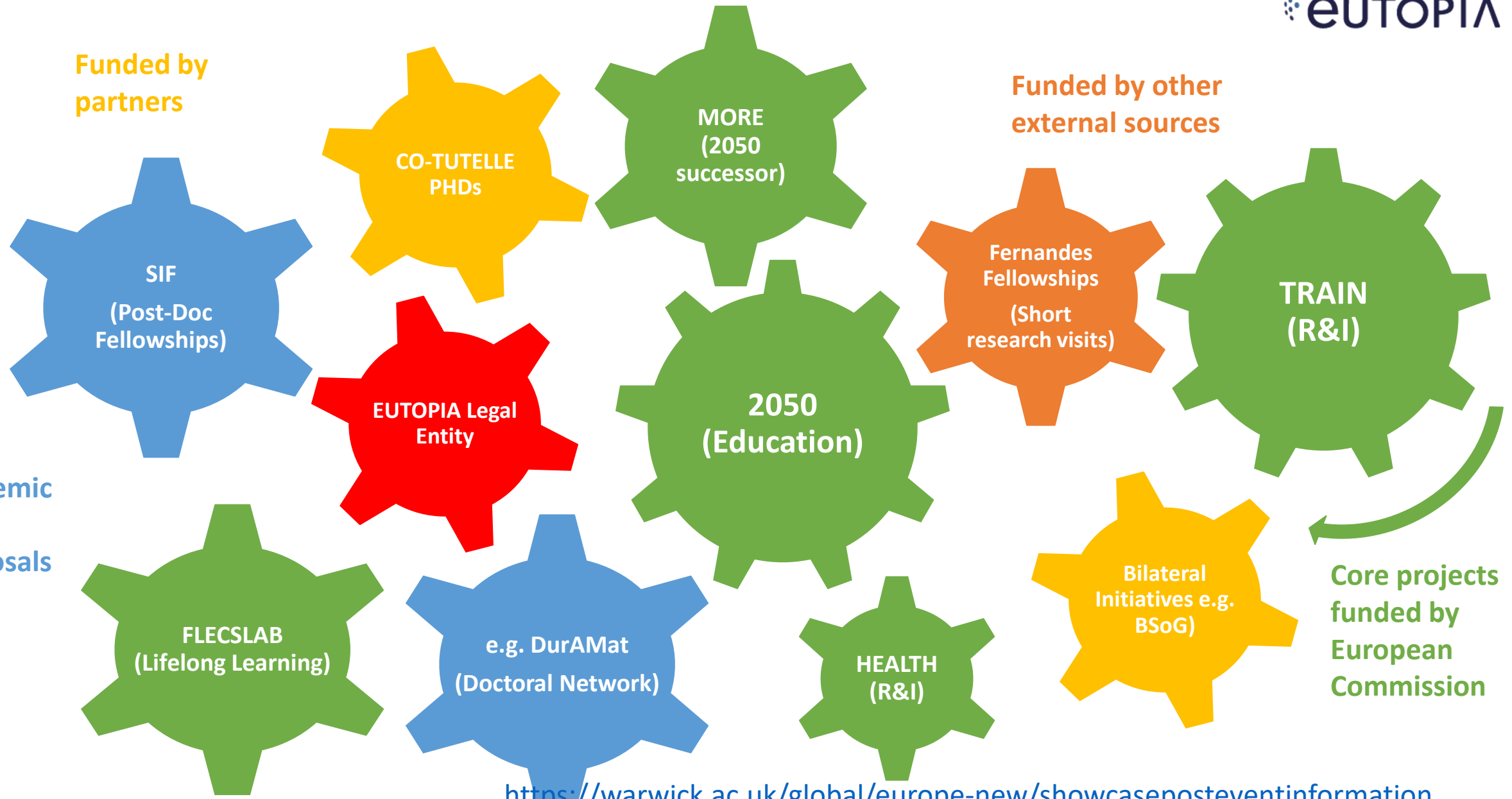

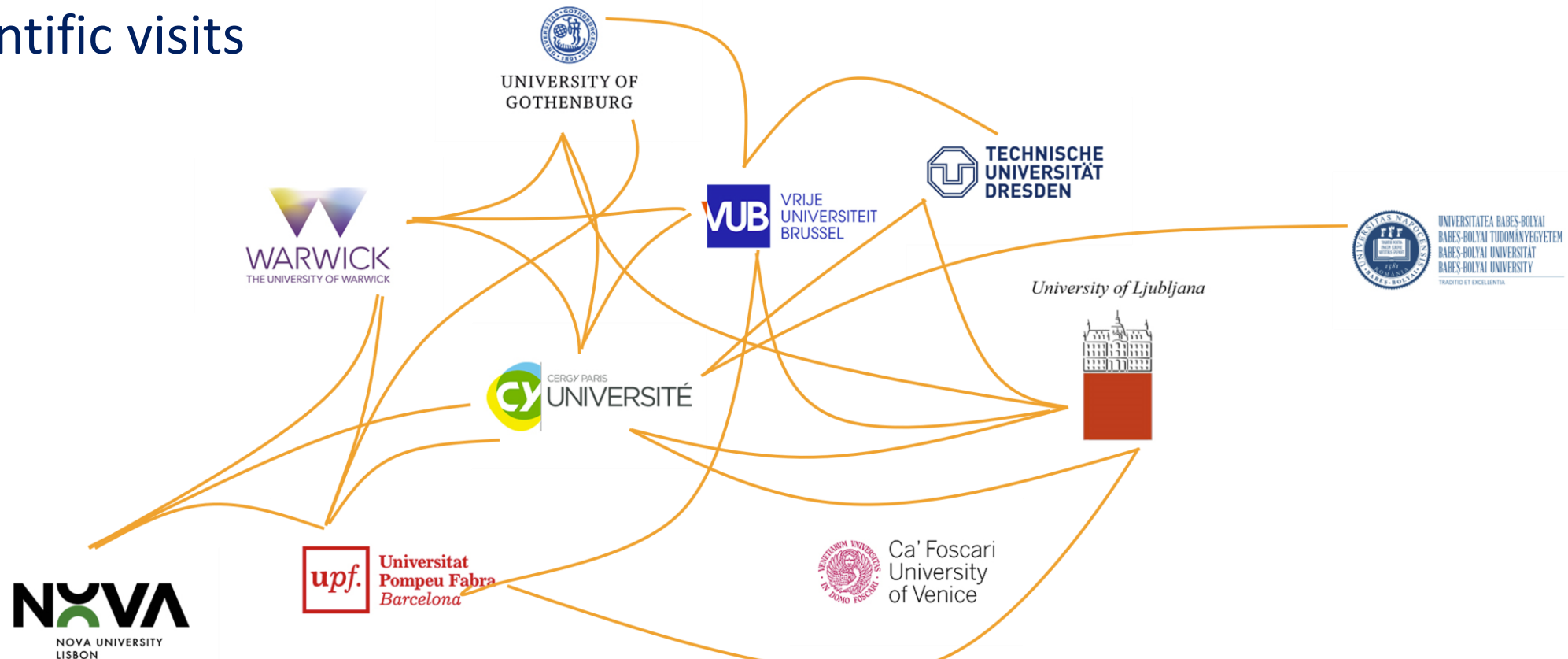

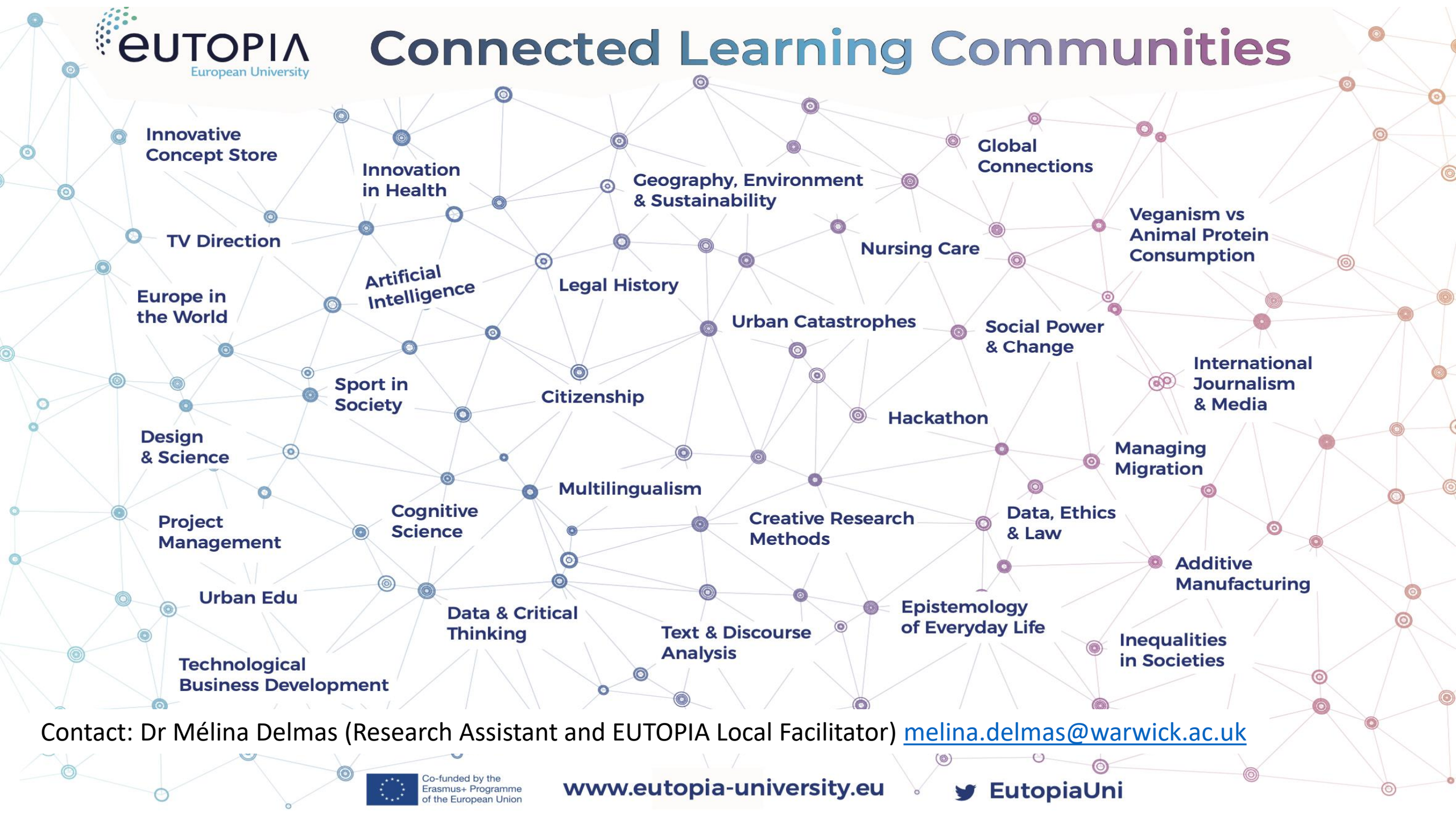

Integrated Education and Research Connected Communities (CCs)

CCs: Building blocks of the EUTOPIA approach for empowering knowledge in EUTOPIA MORE, inspired by the outcomes of the Connected Learning Communities (CLC) and Connected Research Communities (CRC) resulting from the pilot phase of EUTOPIA (2019-2022).

CLC aimed at **cross-campus learning activities within the alliance** among teachers, students and other actors in society in a participatory learning and knowledge creating process.

CRC aimed at **connecting research initiatives across EUTOPIA**, specifically activities related to global challenge or sustainable development.

New integrated **CCs** can be seen as a hybrid:

- Connecting academia and society, teaching and research in cross-campus formats, and inclusion
- Bridging the divide between education and research by offering a research-based learning workshop to the CC students with the support of the EUTOPIA central team.

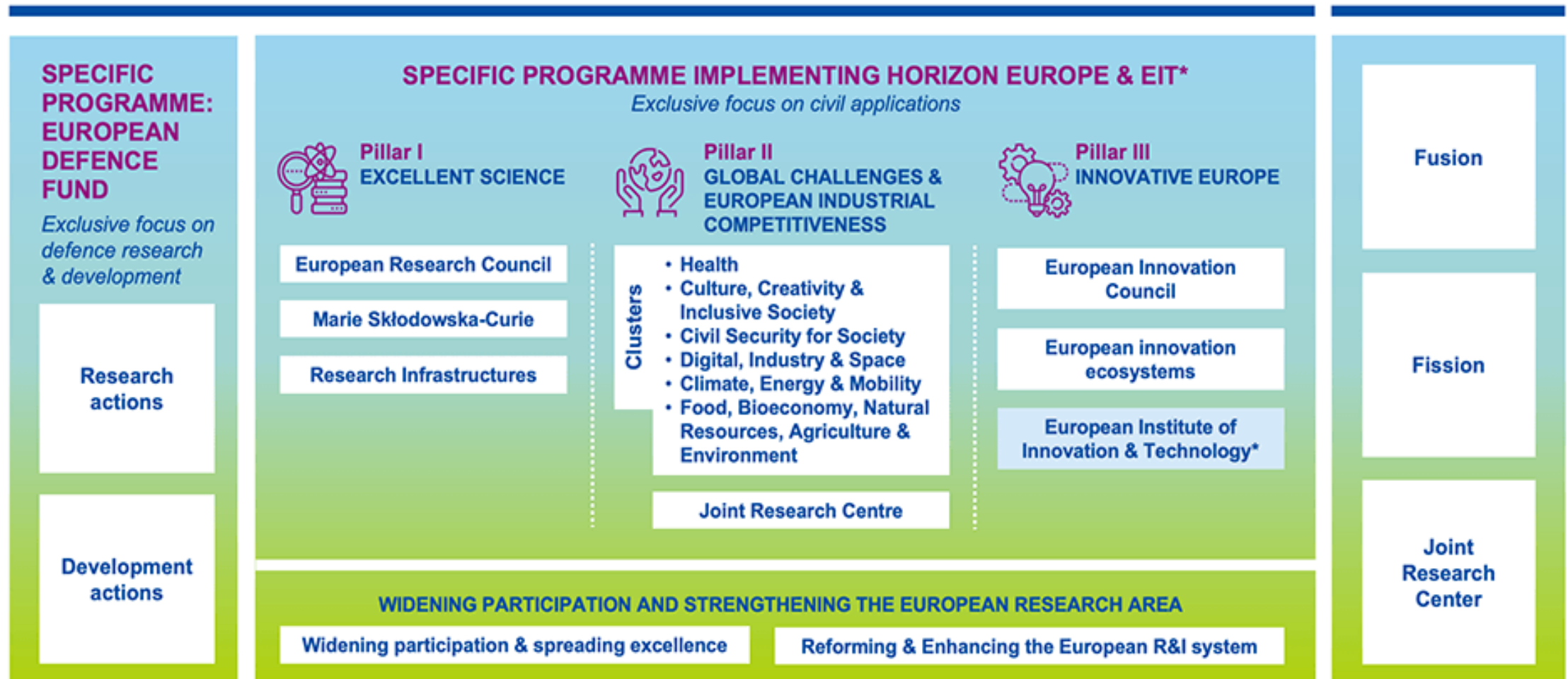

Horizon Europe Funding Opportunities

- [Work Programmes 2023-24](#) set out Horizon Europe funding opportunities to 2024, with latest deadlines in 2025 and in some cases, 2026
- ERC calls:
 - **Consolidator Grant** (deadline 12 Dec 2023), **Advanced Grant** (opening in May 2024, deadline in August 2024); Further ERC calls to be released in the 2025 Work Programme (tbc)
- MSCA calls:
 - **Doctoral Networks** (deadline 28 Nov 2023), **COFUND** (deadline 8 Feb 2024), **Staff Exchanges** (deadline 28 Feb 2024), **Postdoctoral Fellowships** (opening Apr 2024, deadline Sep 2024)
- Pillar 2 consortia calls... too many to mention, 6 Clusters and each Cluster can have up to 50 calls, so best identified via the [EU Funding and Tenders Portal](#)



UK Association to Horizon Europe


- UK entities are currently eligible to apply for Horizon Europe funding
- A deal has been agreed on the UK's entry into the Horizon Europe programme as an Associated Country
- UK association is with effect from the 1st Jan 2024
- **The UK will be able to apply to all 2024 Work Programme calls and beyond for the duration of Horizon Europe as an Associated Country:**
 - Includes 2024 Work Programme calls opening and with deadlines in 2023
 - Calls opening from now onwards are 2024 Work Programmes and hence will be covered by Association
 - Awards under these calls will be funded by the EU directly with UK entities able to lead project consortia
- The UKRI Guarantee scheme will continue to cover 2023 Work Programme calls with the UKRI Guarantee extended to ensure that all 2023 WP calls are covered
 - Includes 2023 Work Programme calls which have deadlines in 2024
- The UK is also associating to the Copernicus Programme. It is not associating to Euratom.

The UKRI Guarantee

- Awards made under Horizon Europe 2021, 2022 & 2023 Work Programme calls will continue to be funded by the UKRI Guarantee and UKRI Guarantee arrangements will apply to these, including:
 - Eligibility to apply as both Partners and Coordinators (without being able to Coordinate once awarded)
 - Requirement to apply as Beneficiary and NOT as Associated Partner to be able to access the Guarantee funds
 - Switched to Associated Partner only once awarded to then be able to make a UKRI Guarantee application
- The UKRI Guarantee will continue to cover up to 100% of the costs applied for in the original HE application.
- Projects already funded by the UKRI Guarantee will continue to be covered by this for the project duration. It will not be possible for these projects to be covered by Association instead.
- Also applies to transfers of awards from other countries (2021-23 WP calls transfers will not be covered by the EU, will require converting into a UKRI Guarantee award instead)

Identifying the EU Work Programme a call belongs to

- Horizon Europe calls can be found on the [EU Funding and Tenders Portal](#) (see next slide) and in the [EU Work Programmes](#).
- The call identifier or ‘call ID’ includes the Work Programme year, see picture:
- Call IDs with the year ‘2024’ are covered by Association, call IDs with the year ‘2023’ are covered by the UKRI Guarantee (this is regardless of when the call opens and closes).

Funding Calls under Pillar 1: Excellent Science

European Research Council (ERC)

The ERC funds ground-breaking, high-gain/high-risk research at the frontiers of science. Its funding is for an individual fellow with a team. Any fields/topics are eligible.

ERC schemes consist of:

- Starting Grants (StG)/ Consolidator Grants (CoG)/ Advanced Grants (AdG);
- Synergy Grants (SyG);
- Proof of Concept Grants (PoC).

ERC proposals will now need to include a [Gender Equality Plan](#) (or equivalent) for host institutions to be in place for the duration of the project at the latest by the time of the Grant Agreement preparation. See the [university's Gender Equality Plan](#).


Pillar 1 aims to promote scientific excellence and attract highly-skilled researchers and innovators to Europe. It aims to reinforce EU scientific leadership through:
