Objectives

1. Research visualisation

Visualise the landscape of the University's interdisciplinary (e.g., SDG-related) research

2. Collaboration facilitation

Facilitate cross-disciplinary and cross-faculty collaboration within the University for large-scale funding applications

3. Practice improvement

Improve the reporting and evaluation practices of the University's SDG-relevant research (e.g., for university rankings)

A service rather than a planform

As a service, end-users don't need to engage with or understand any technical details of the visualisation tool before using it.

Two types of services

1. Regular reports as decks of slides

- Research patterns, trends, and networks over the past years
- Termly updates to be incorporated into committee meetings at various levels
- Annual report for cross-university comparisons
