ARRIVAL INSTRUCTIONS (Car, Bus, Taxi)

For students living on campus

Arrivals 2020/2021

Changes may need to be made to the following arrival instructions so please ensure you check for any changes 48 hours before your planned arrival. Any changes will be uploaded onto this document which you can access via the same link.

Prior to your arrival please ensure you read the latest government guidance for [Entering the UK: Quarantining when you arrive in the UK - GOV.UK \(www.gov.uk\)](#).

Please be aware that we are currently asking all new arrivals to complete their self-isolation in one of our campus conference facilities, unless you have travelled from or transited through a country on the UK travel 'Red List' and completed your 10 day isolation within a government approved [quarantine hotel](#). If this is the case then you will need to provide evidence of your quarantine stay and your two negative test results that were conducted during your stay. You will then be able to move into your contracted accommodation.

If you do need to complete your self-isolation in one of our campus conference facilities, you will not be charged for this in addition to your accommodation contract and we will be providing you with three meals a day as you will not have access to kitchen facilities. If you arrive before your accommodation contract is due to begin an additional charge will apply for the campus conference stay for this additional period of time.

If arriving from an overseas country not on the UK travel 'Red List', you can move into your contracted accommodation once you have:

- Received two negative lateral flow tests from your pre-booked [travel test package](#) and completed your 10 day self-isolation **OR** received a negative COVID-19 test result, as per the test to release [guidance](#)

If arriving from within the UK, you can move into your contracted accommodation once you have:

- Received two negative lateral flow test results, as per the government guidance. These should be booked three days apart from the facility on campus. Find out more about booking your lateral flow tests [here](#)

You will need to provide evidence of your test results when you pick up your room key at Student Services. Keys for students arriving after 27th September 2020 and living on campus will be available for collection from Student Services based in Senate House, right in the centre of campus. Please ensure you follow the instructions in this document and the signage on site to arrive at Student Services and not to your residence.

COVID-19 Guidance

Before you arrive

This year, in light of the global Covid-19 pandemic, there are some additional important steps that you should take in preparation for your arrival:

Additional Guidance

Before you arrive to collect your keys you must ensure that you and any members of your household have been Covid-19 [symptom free](#) for at least 10 days. If you have experienced symptoms within this period you will need to delay your arrival. As a reminder, we are currently asking all new arrivals to complete self-isolation in one of our on campus conference facilities, unless you have completed your 10 day isolation within a government approved quarantine hotel. You will not be charged for this in addition to your accommodation contract and we will be providing you with three meals a day as you will not have access to kitchen facilities. If you arrive before your accommodation contract is due to begin an additional charge will apply for the campus conference stay for this additional period of time.

Please also adhere to the most up to date social distancing guidance issued by UK Government. There will be signage upon your arrival to assist you with this including keeping a 2m distance from others and following any one-way systems that are in place.

In order to keep everyone safe during arrivals we request that you only bring a maximum of two other members of your household with you to assist with your move, however they must not enter the accommodation block.

The University has its own policy on [wearing face coverings](#), which you should review before your arrival. In addition, we are providing you with a free washable face covering, along with a thermometer, to enable you to take your own temperature and help us to better track the potential spread of Covid-19. You are not obliged to take your temperature; we are providing this only as a useful aid. Both your face covering and thermometer can be collected at Student Services on your arrival.

Have a safe journey and we look forward to welcoming you.

Arriving by Car after 27th September

Please note you should currently avoid car sharing with anyone outside your household or support bubble. If this is not possible you should rigorously follow the [safer travel guidance](#) for passengers to reduce the risk of transmission to others. If arriving by car, you can use the postcode CV4 7AL which will guide you to Warwick Campus. Please then follow the instructions below to direct you to Senate House in the centre of campus where you can collect the keys to your accommodation:

Approaching the University via the A45

- Exit the A45 at the roundabout onto Sir Henry Parkes Road
- Cross over the first roundabout (second exit) continuing on Sir Henry Parkes Road
- At the second roundabout take the second exit onto Kirby Corner Road
- Continue along Kirby Corner Road to the roundabout and take the first exit on to Gibbet Hill Road
- At the next roundabout take the first exit onto Lord Bhattacharyya Way and continue along the road
- There is a temporary road closure in place on University road to provide additional space for Social Distancing. Please follow the diversion around Academic Loop Road.
- Re-join University road and follow it round to Health Centre Road on the left. There is short stay parking available where you can park whilst you collect the keys to your accommodation
- Senate House is directly opposite, across the main road

Approaching the University via the A46

- Exit the A46 via the slip road and turn onto Stoneleigh Road towards the University
- Cross over the first roundabout (second exit) continuing on Stoneleigh Road
- At the second roundabout continue straight (second exit) on to Gibbet Hill Road
- You will see a large University of Warwick sign on your right hand side letting you know that you are now on campus. Continue down the hill and at the roundabout cross over (second exit) staying on Gibbet Hill Road
- At the next roundabout again continue straight (first exit) to stay on Gibbet Hill Road
- At the third roundabout turn right onto Lord Bhattacharyya Way and continue round along the road
- There is a temporary road closure in place on University road to provide additional space for Social Distancing. Please follow the diversion around Academic Loop Road.
- Re-join University road and follow it round to Health Centre Road on the left. There is short stay parking available where you can park whilst you collect the keys to your accommodation. Senate House is directly opposite, across the main road

On Arrival

Report to a member of staff at Student Services to collect your conference room key and Warwick ID card. You may be asked for your Warwick ID number to confirm your details. You will then be provided with instructions to complete self-isolation in one of our on campus conference facilities.

Arriving by Bus after 27th September

Buses will stop at the bus interchange on central campus. The bus stop is just a short walk from Senate House where you will collect your keys from Student Services. You should follow [government guidance](#) when using public transport.

On Arrival

Report to a member of staff at student services to collect your conference room key and Warwick ID card. You may be asked for your Warwick ID number to confirm your details. You will then be provided with instructions to complete self-isolation in one of our on campus conference facilities.

Arriving by Taxi after 27th September

You should direct your taxi driver to follow the directions provided above for cars. There is a taxi drop off available on Health Centre Road (opposite Senate House). You should follow [government guidance](#) when using public transport.

On Arrival

Report to a member of staff at student services to collect your conference room key and Warwick ID card. You may be asked for your Warwick ID number to confirm your details. You will then be provided with instructions to complete self-isolation in one of our on campus conference facilities.
