


The University of Warwick Art Collection

The art collection is inside lots of different University buildings and outside across campus.

Warwick Arts Centre – Front Entrance




This is the front entrance to the building. There is a sign on the building saying Warwick Arts Centre. It has large glass doors and the ones on the right-hand side open automatically as you approach them.


The Arts Centre is usually open from 9 – 11pm every day. Opening times do vary according to the shows finishing times.

The Arts Centre is located at the heart of a busy campus. It can be noisy and busy at certain times of the day.

If you enter the building through the main entrance a wide gradual ramp leads you to the Gallery to the left and a large open area to the right. A curving staircase to your right provides access to the first floor and the cinemas.



If you walk to the end of the ramp and turn right, you will see a sign that says Info & Tickets. This is the Box Office where you can get information, collect tickets and buy tickets.




Warwick Arts Centre - Side Entrance



This is the side entrance of the building. There is a sign on the building that says Warwick Arts Centre.

This side entrance is up a few steps with accessible ramp.



The Arts Centre can get noisy and busy and there are sometimes loud announcements.

How to get around

You will find lots of signs for the different venues, Gallery, Theatre, Studio, Butterworth Hall, Helen Martin Studio, Creative Learning Space, Music Centre, Woods Scawen Room



You will also see signs for the toilets, changing place and the Lift.



There are stairs to reach the different levels within the building. At the side entrance to the Arts Centre there is a main staircase with a stair-lift facing you as you enter.



There is also a ramp.



If you enter via the front entrance and proceed down the ramp you will see a set of double doors with a sign above them for the lift. The lift is through the double doors.

There are toilets on both levels of the Arts Centre and a cloakroom located on the ground floor.



Box Office



Box Office is on the ground floor to the right as you enter the main entrance, or to the left if you enter through the side entrance. Please come here if you have any questions. You may need to wait for assistance. You can also collect tickets from here, information leaflets on coming shows and all the sculpture trails currently available.



Box Office staff



Sometimes our members of staff may need to wear a mask, to protect visitors to the building during the pandemic.



They are here to help you. They wear blue and black uniforms. They are very friendly and happy to help.

Operations Assistants

They can usually be found helping people before the start of a cinema showing or event in the Arts Centre.



They wear a blue and white check shirt and navy gilet or jacket. They usually carry a walkie talkie and a large set of keys. They are also very friendly and happy to help.

Creative Learning Space



The Creative Learning Space provides activities for families, adults, students, teenagers and children of all ages. This can include painting, drawing, sculpting, dancing and music. It is open every Saturday 2 – 4pm. It can get very busy, noisy and messy.

It can be muddy while exploring the sculptures




Inside

Parking

On arrival at the University of Warwick, follow the highway signage for Central Campus. Multiple car parks are available on Central Campus, all close to Warwick Arts Centre.

Parking charges are listed below. Please note all parking charges are now pay by phone.

Monday to Friday (excluding Bank Holidays) between 6am and 5pm:

Up to 2 hours – £2.00

Up to 3 hours – £3.00

Up to 4 hours – £4.00


All Day – £7.00

Monday to Friday Evenings between 5pm and 6am, all day weekends and Bank Holidays: £1

Blue badge holder parking is available at the rear of Senate House and on Health Centre Road. Blue badge holder parking is free at all times. During busy times, an Arts Centre parking steward may be available to assist with additional limited mobility parking. Please contact Box Office on 024 7652 4524 with any queries or to find out more about blue badge parking.
