Job purpose (a brief summary of the role)	To assist the Team Leader to maintain and develop the University gardens, ensuring all works are completed safely and to the highest standards.
Duties and responsibilities	To assist in maintaining the borders, turf, trees, ponds, wild areas, and wildflower displays to agreed standards.  To assist in the planting of soft landscape schemes.  To help erect fencing to maintain our boundaries and protect our borders.  To help maintain a safe outside environment in all weather conditions including clearing snow and ice.  To use a broad range of machinery and equipment such as mowers, hedge cutters and All-Terrain Vehicles to a safe standard.  To ensure the correct use and storage of all machinery, equipment, and fuels.  To ensure risk assessments and Standard Operating Procedures are adhered to for all tasks across the Gardens department.  Clean, tidy and presentable appearance.  Able to work within the organisation's working hours/pattern between the hours of 8am to 4pm on a 5-day basis.
	Apprenticeship  To attend college as required and complete coursework in a timely manner as part of the apprenticeship scheme.
