- 7. At 31 July 1988 loans in respect of capital expenditure previously incurred and outstanding to the Foundation Fund were £1,326,000 (1987 £1,409,000) and secured loans repayable to Building Societies were £2,314,000 (1987 £673,000).
- 8. For insurance purposes, the buildings and equipment are valued at £134,779,000.
- 9. The University holds 9130 shares of fl each and a 1% debenture loan of £774,180 issued by University of Warwick Science Park Limited. The investment has been included in the accounts at nil value.
- 10. The University is involved in a legal dispute over faults which have developed in tiling facades to a number of University buildings. The cost of the rectification work and legal costs paid to 31st July 1988 have been included in the University's Income & Expenditure Account. No provision for continuing legal costs has been made however, as the University considers that it is likely that such costs will be recovered.
