Warwick Guest

Warwick Guest is a wireless network available to conference attendees, short-term guests and visitors to the University of Warwick. This is a free to use service providing access from a laptop or mobile device to public pages.

Individuals holding University of Warwick IT login credentials (e.g. current staff and students, longer term visitors) are encouraged to use the eduroam service instead.

The Warwick Guest service is provided by BT. Users of the service are subject to BT's own terms and conditions. There are links to the BT Terms & Conditions on the landing page.

Getting Started

Select Warwick Guest from the list of available wireless networks

Open your web browser and you should be directed to the BT Wi-Fi landing page

Click the Get Online button to connect



Features

Wireless network access is available within most University buildings
Devices are dynamically allocated an IPv4 address in a private address range

Restrictions

Warwick Guest is provided for visitors and does not provide access to the internal campus network

Service Hours

24 hours a day, seven days a week, 365 days a year

Service Availability
