

Feedback for EPSRC Funding

Jassim Happa – Organisation and running of a 2-day conference: Theory and Practice of Computer Graphics (TP.CG) 2011 conference.
8 – 9th September 2011, WMG, International Digital Laboratory, University of Warwick.

We received a good number of manuscripts and selected sixteen for oral presentations and seven for poster presentation. More than 40 attendees could see presentations on the following fields: Natural Phenomena, Geometry, Computer Graphics Applications, Human Computer Interaction and Systems and Rendering. We got very positive feedback from the attendees.

The conference allowed us to take a central role in new multi-disciplinary collaboration between research institutes, industry and other universities. We took the opportunity to discuss recent and future collaboration with different representatives of computer graphics labs across the Europe. Based on the conference organisation success, Dr. Czanner has become a permanent Eurographics UK committee member.

Several Warwick academics, PhD students and staff were involved in the organisation of the conference. Conference had 40 registered participants. Impact could be measured in conference participation, paper submissions as well as conference feedback based on participants' opinion. We got very positive feedback from the participants. Scientific papers were published in a form of conference proceedings by Eurographics <http://diglib.eg.org/>, and will be available for general public in the ACM Digital Library.
