## Description

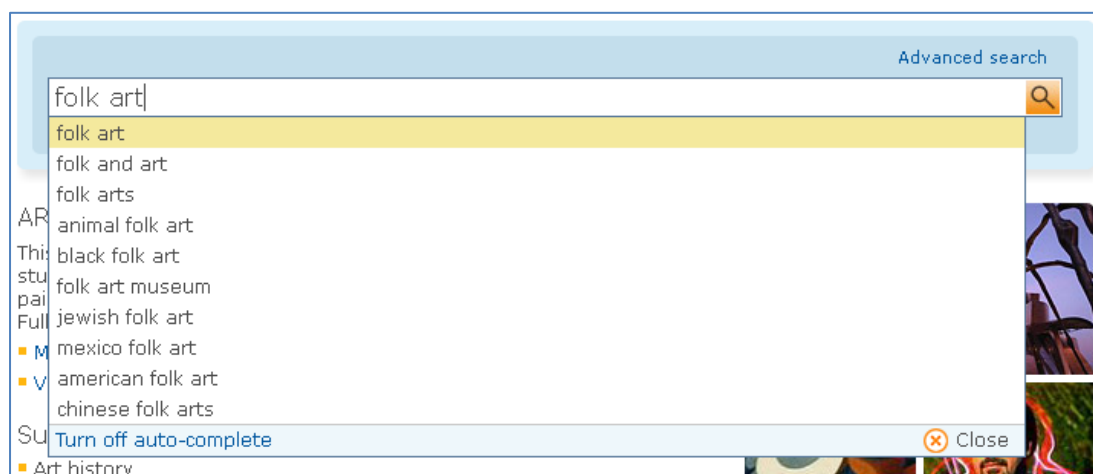
ARTbibliographies Modern provides access to abstracts of journal articles, exhibition catalogues, essays and reviews on all forms of modern and contemporary art from the late 19th century onwards.

## Access

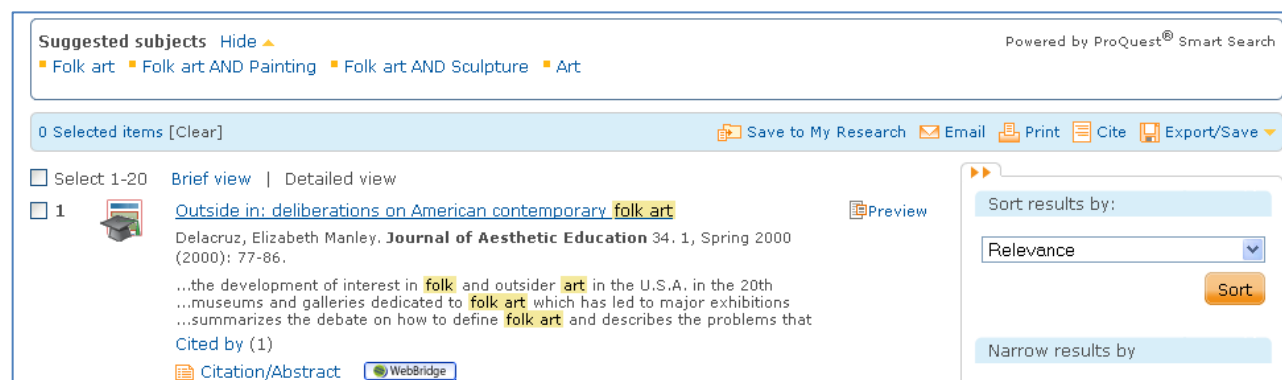
Access ABM via the [Library research databases](#). Select **e-resources; databases**. Sign in using your Warwick username and password.

## Searching





You can carry out a basic search from the home page with your keywords to search the database. Suggested keywords will appear as you type.



Your results will show a list of articles that match your search terms with your keywords highlighted. The icon to the left indicates the type of resource, for example a scholarly journal. Click on the **title** to see more details about the articles. Suggested topics are displayed at the top for further searching.

Use the 'Sort results' option at the right of the screen to narrow your results.

You can select 'peer reviewed' articles only, limit your search by publication date, or specify a particular subject area, e.g. 'religion and art'.

The **advanced search** provides more options for combining keywords. You can also refine your search by searching within the abstract, author, or document title.

### Finding full text

Some of the results will be available in full text and will provide a link to a PDF file to download. Others will show the **WebBridge** link.



Click on **WebBridge** where you see the icon and it will search the Library's other online resources to see if the article is available .

For materials not available in the Library, you may request them using the **Article Reach service**.

### Managing your results

the titles that you are interested in by ticking the boxes on the left and view **Selected items**. You can then either email, print, or export the results to a reference management system.

### My Research

Create a 'My Research' account with ProQuest to enable you to save searches and documents, and create alerts by email or RSS feed. It also allows sharing of lists with other users. Click on 'My Research' at the top of the screen and complete the registration form to create an account.
