WRAP

 Warwick Research Archive Portal (WRAP) is the University of Warwick's institutional repository. It is a full text, open access service showcasing and preserving research outputs of the Warwick community.

What are the benefits?

- Increase the global visibility and impact of your work
- Supports the University's **REF** (**Research Excellence Framework**) submission, providing a collection of high quality records to draw upon
- Acts as a compliant repository for REF Open Access policy
- Single, secure location that links to other institutional and external systems and processes. This includes the Ideate departmental profiles & Cognos system.
- Showcases the full range of research created by the University for potential collaborators, students and investors
- Rigorous checking of copyright policy by a dedicated team
- Professional quality metadata (catalogue records) to describe your work
- Provides you with a persistent web link. Also links out to the final published version using the digital object identifier (DOI) where possible
- Indexed by Google/Google Scholar to raise your academic profile


HEFCE Policy on Open Access for REF2021

HEFCE OA in more detail (1): Included/Excluded

- Outputs required to be OA for the REF
 - Journal articles
 - Conference proceedings (published in a journal)
- Outputs <u>NOT</u> required to be OA
 - Books, book chapters, other long-form publications
 - Conference proceedings (published as a book/ISBN)
 - Creative writing
 - Practice-based outputs
 - Data

HEFCE OA in more detail (2): Eligibility for REF

- To be considered OA outputs must be:
 - -The 'accepted author manuscript' (final after peer review) or published version
 - Deposited in WRAP or a compliant subject repository
 - Deposited on acceptance for publication
 - Mandatory for outputs accepted for publication after 01 April 2016

Key message: deposit to WRAP

 On acceptance for publication, authors should send author accepted version to the Library via the online form: warwick.ac.uk/irsubmit

 The Library will make all necessary checks and confirm deposit, noting any applicable exceptions allowed under the policy.

HEFCE (3): Embargo Periods

- 24 months for Arts and Humanities/Social Sciences
- 12 months Science/Medical subjects
- 24 months is acceptable for interdisciplinary research submitted to Science/Medicine Panels if it is also admissible to Arts/Social Sciences
- **Deposit your work**; if it is under embargo or there are other issues we will keep it on "closed access" for the necessary period

HEFCE (4): Exceptions

Deposit/Technical

 E.g., need for multiple author permissions delayed submission of the work; legal/ethical; short term repository failure

Access

- Dependence on 3rd part content and rights not granted in time or at all (e.g., images)
- Embargo period is beyond the maximum but it is the most appropriate publication
- Journal prohibits OA repository deposit but it is the most appropriate publication








"Search" - by Author/Editor or Title or Department









RCUK Policy and Fund

- Peer-reviewed journal articles and conference proceedings
- Projects funded 'wholly or partially' by RCUK
- Gold OA expected with a CC-BY licence type
- A range of acceptable embargo periods for Green OA
 - 6-12 months in the first instance (6 months EPSRC)
 - 12-24 months once funding has been exhausted
- RCUK have provided Warwick with a block grant to support Gold OA

Two steps to make your article compliant with the RCUK policy:

- It must be published in a journal compliant with the RCUK Policy on Access to Research Outputs
- It must include:
 - a statement on funding source/s
 - a statement on how "underlying research materials –
 such as data, samples or models can be accessed*"

^{*}This does not mean the data itself needs to be OA – it means you say how the reader can access it, or where there are sensitivities in the data, you note this

To comply with COAF

- Article or conference proceeding with ISSN must be freely available on publication
- The licence used must be CC-BY (Creative Commons Attribution) only
- The publisher must also on behalf of the author deposit the final version in PubMed Central (PMC)
