

## **Student Discipline Review Group (SDRG)**

### **For Sexual Violence and Misconduct**



### **Remit**

Based on the report provided by the Investigating Officer (IO) and the balance of the evidence considered, the SDRG will consider whether or not the case should proceed to a Disciplinary Committee.

### **Membership**

- Director of Student Discipline and Resolution (or nominee) (Chair)
- Director of Legal and Compliance (or nominee) (Alternate Chair)
- Director of Wellbeing and Safeguarding (or nominee)
- Senior Assistant Registrar Student Discipline and Resolution (or nominee)
- Director of HR (or nominee)

In attendance:

- Students' Union representative (standing invite)
- Student Liaison Officer (as required)
- Investigating Officer (as required)

### **Terms of Reference**

The SDRG may determine that:

- further information or clarification of the report is necessary; this could involve a review of information held by the Student Discipline and Resolution Team, information from Residential Life Team, the IO or others; and may require the IO to conduct further investigations.
- Once the SDRG are satisfied that they have sufficient information to make a recommendation, there are 3 actions that can be taken:

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1. If the SDRG agree with the IO's report that there is sufficient evidence to warrant the matter being further considered under Regulation 23.
  - recommendation made to the Registrar to proceed either to a Student Discipline Committee or a Director Decision
  - if the Registrar agrees or has given delegated authority to the Chair of SDRG, all parties are notified of the outcome
  - the relevant documents are passed to the Disciplinary Committee Secretary or the Director of Student Discipline and Resolution
