

What is OLS?

- Online Linguistic Support (OLS) is a free online language-learning platform designed for Erasmus+
- With OLS, you can test your current level in the language you will use while you are abroad.
- Your results will not prevent you from taking part in an Erasmus+, but will give you access to an OLS language course!
- OLS complements face-to-face teaching, allowing you to develop your skills outside the classroom. It also provides you with collaborative and peer learning opportunities.

Who is it for?

If you have been selected for the Erasmus+ you can benefit from OLS. We will allocate you a test licence and you will receive an invitation email with your login details. You may then be issued with a training licence.

Is OLS test mandatory for you?

- **Compulsory** - Student Mobility will allocate a license to all students who are required to participate, if this is you, you will receive an email from the OLS programme by the end of August. If you receive this please go to the OLS website to make sure that you are aware of your responsibilities.
- **Optional** – Following this Student Mobility will send an email to all remaining Erasmus+ students to offer them the opportunity to take advantage of the free programme in support of their Mobility. Please respond to the email from Student Mobility as licences will be issued on a 'first come first served basis'.
