Student Visa	<ul> <li>For all incoming exchange students (non-Hong Kong citizens), you are required for a student visa to study in HK. Student visa documents must be submitted in a TIMELY manner or will be withdrawn.</li> <li>Please expect that student visas may take up to 3 months to be approved by the Director of Immigration Department of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR).</li> <li>For Mainland Chinese students holding PRC passport, you will need an additional 2-4 weeks to apply for an EEP from your hometown after you have received your approved visa label.</li> </ul>

Accommodation Info	<ul> <li>Only undergraduate students might be accommodated in double occupancy student halls. It is NOT guaranteed, subject to availability. Room preferences is not entertained. Hall assignments are all decided by the housing office. Details to be stipulated in application portal.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>For postgraduate students, off campus accommodation is available near Clearwater Bay, such as Hang Hau just 15 minutes from campus on public transports or Sai Kung.</li> <li>The price range is from HK\$7,000- 10,000 per month for a single room. Rates, government rent and management fees exclusive.</li> </ul>

Class Format	Lectures, computer simulations, case discussions, individual and group projects.	
Grading System	4.3 grading scale, letter graded, with grade D as marginal pass.	
Course Requirement	Exchange students can select SHSS courses as long as they meet the prerequisite requirements and are subject to space availabilities. Some courses may require professor approval for enrollment.	
Attendance	Class participation is mandatory and part of the student's final grade in most courses. Select your courses carefully and enroll only if you can commit.	
Examinations	Format of exams varies. Final exams are within the last 2 weeks of school. Students are responsible to stay in HK until the last day of finals. Requests for early leave of exams are normally not considered.
