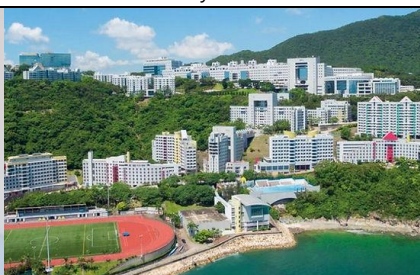
No bed linen/pillows/blankets are provided due to sanitary reasons. Students are recommended to purchase a bed protector for the duration of their stay.

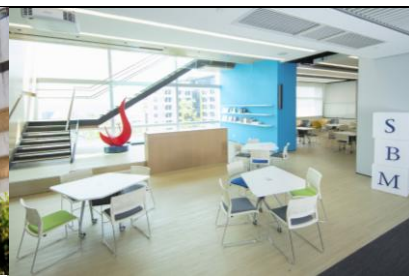


Estimated Living Expenses

Estimated Break-Down of Costs per Semester for reference (in HKD):

ATTENDANCE

Students are expected to attend ALL courses in person. Early exam leave for personal reasons will not be entertained.

Learning Expectations

Language of Instruction:	English is the medium of instruction for the Business School
Class Format:	Lectures, Case Analysis/Presentations, Papers, and Projects
Class Attendance:	Class attendance is mandatory until the last day of classes
Class Participation:	Class participation is part of the student's final grade in most courses
Course Grading:	4.3 grading scale, letter graded, with grade D as marginal pass; final course grade often based on class participation, projects, case analysis, mid-term and final exams. Some courses are graded on a curve.
Class Size:	Normally 30 – 40 students per a class for 2000 - 4000 level courses.
Course Load:	A maximum total of 5 courses within 17 credits in total.
Course Choices:	Exchange students can select if the prerequisite requirements are met and space is available. Some courses may require professor approval to enroll.
Examinations:	Exam formats vary. Final exams are written in the last 2 weeks of the term. Students are responsible for remaining in HK until the last day of finals. Requests for early exams are normally not considered.
Transcripts:	Students receive 2 free e-transcripts around 6-8 weeks after the semester: one to their personal emails and one to their home institutions.
