# What is a Degree Apprenticeship?

A Degree Apprenticeship is a programme that combines work with study, developed by universities and employers. A Degree Apprentice will spend 80 per cent of their time learning on-the-job, and 20 per cent training off-the-job studying towards their degree. Programmes are delivered in either one-week blocks spaced throughout the year or as day release, one day a week. On successful completion, your apprentice will graduate with a full bachelor's or master's degree, giving you the opportunity to maximise the return on your levy investment.
