What's involved?

Employer engagement can include:

- Talks from employers in your sector at on-campus events
- Work placements (Virtual and in-person)
- Networking with professionals
- Insight days at employers (sector dependent)

University engagement can include:

- A National Conference residential
- Taster lectures
- Talking to current students studying subjects linked to the sectors
- UCAS and personal statement support
- Apprenticeship advice and guidance

Benefits of taking part in a Pathways programme:

- Gain insight into what University life is like
- Explore career opportunities within your sector
- Boost your confidence, and meet likeminded people
- Develop key skills and gain experiences for your CV
- Upon successful completion, you may be eligible for a reduced offer of up to 2 grades when applying to study at Warwick

Eligibility

- Be in Year 12 at the start of the programme
- Attend, and have always attended a state-funded or non-fee paying school/college
- Live within a reasonable commuting distance of the University of Warwick

In addition to this:

- Be in the first generation of your family to attend university
- Have been eligible for free school meals whilst in secondary school
- Have attended schools with lower than average progression to Higher Education, or a school with higher than average proportion of students who qualify for Free School Meals
- Live in a neighbourhood with a low rate of progression to Higher Education or high level of socio-economic deprivation
- Have been looked after, in care or a young carer
- For Engineering only – Currently studying A level Maths or Physics

The more criteria you meet, the more likely you are to be offered a place on the programme.
