

<b>11<sup>TH</sup> MARCH</b>	Information about our nomination process to your home University.
<b>20<sup>TH</sup> MARCH</b>	BSB's Online application platform opens.
<b>BEFORE 7<sup>TH</sup> APRIL</b>	Complete applications received.
<b>30<sup>TH</sup> APRIL</b>	Approval of the programme chosen by your coordinator at BSB. You and your home university will be contacted if there are any changes. <i>Your coordinator will advise you about the most appropriate programme according to your previous studies.</i> Accommodation information sent by e-mail.
<b>EARLY MAY</b>	Acceptance letters sent by e-mail and by post (only if necessary) to your home University.
<b>10<sup>TH</sup> MAY</b>	Reception of your BSB e-mail address and password to connect our IT system, instructions to fill in your personal information as well as to choose your courses. <i>Double Degree students do not have to choose their courses.</i>
<b>JUNE</b>	Online arrival pick-up registration form for students wishing to be met at Dijon train station.
<b>BEGINNING OF JULY</b>	Online registration for an optional Gastronomic day-trip. <i>We organize two day-trips on Saturdays in September, approximate cost: 30 euros.</i>
<b>2 WEEKS BEFORE YOUR ARRIVAL</b>	Practical information sent by e-mail: checklist, train station pick up instructions, explanation on how to reach Dijon and BSB, opening hours of residences, opening a French bank account.
<b>DEPENDING ON YOUR PROGRAMME: END OF AUGUST OR BEGINNING OF SEPTEMBER</b>	Dijon train station pick up + Orientation days. If you'll stay more than one semester: registration to the French Health Insurance system.
<b>MID-DECEMBER OR MID-APRIL 2019</b> (DEPENDING ON THE DURATION OF YOUR STAY)	Farewell party for students finishing their exchange at BSB. Satisfaction Survey about the exchange period.
<b>FEBRUARY 2020 FOR FALL SEMESTER</b> <b>JUNE 2020 FOR SPRING SEMESTER</b>	Transcripts sent directly to your home University.
