Whether you are looking to boost your existing knowledge or would like to gain knowledge in a new area, we have a Summer School course to suit you.

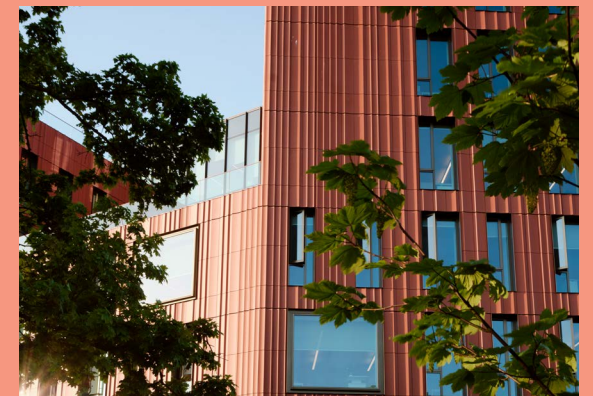
With a range of subjects to choose from, you will interact with renowned academics and high-profile guest speakers.

Warwick Summer School 2026 course options

Taught by Warwick staff, our courses are packed with 60 hours of contact time, including: lectures, seminars and high-profile guest speakers. You can select one of the following courses:

- Artificial Intelligence: A Practical Introduction
- Common Law Contracts, Arbitration and Advocacy
- Communications and Marketing
- Global Connections: Institutions, Mobilities and Cultures
- Global Finance, Money and Banking
- International Business and Finance
- International Relations, Security and Development
- Pre-PhD: Postgraduate Research Preparation
- Strategic Management

All Summer School courses are suitable for students or professionals 18+, who are currently studying (or who have previously studied) at undergraduate or postgraduate level.

You will be awarded a certificate of attendance upon completion of the programme and if you sit the optional course assessment, you will also be sent an official University of Warwick transcript of results. This can usually be used for credit transfer at your home institution - in previous years, students who have successfully transferred credits for our courses have received 15 CATS/7.5 ECTS/3 US credits.

All our courses can also be combined with our additional Exploring British Culture Week or Preparatory English Online Programme.

Exploring British Culture Week

Preparatory English – Online

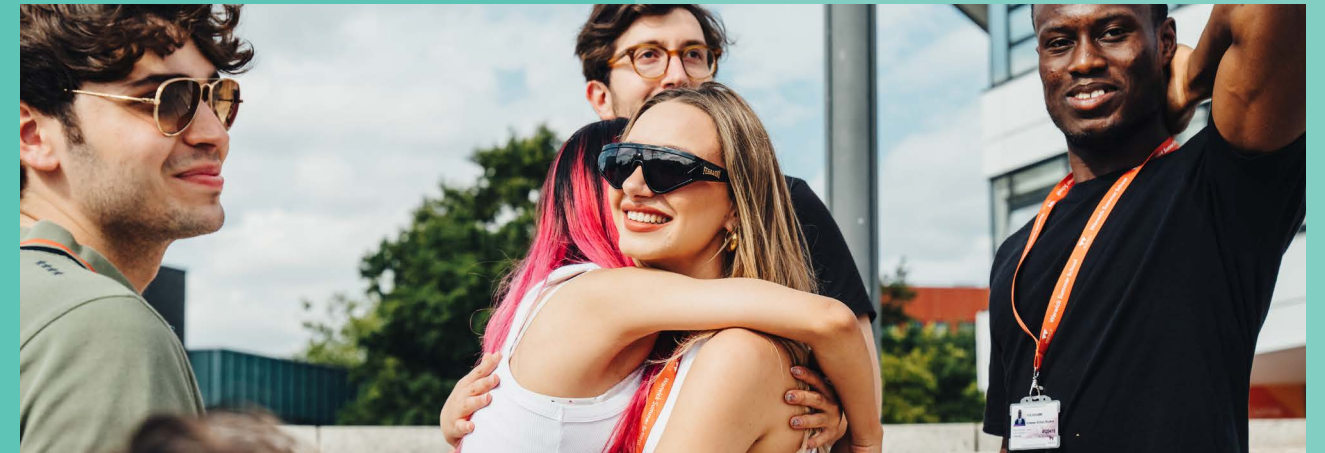
Why Warwick?

Campus life

Warwick Summer School students study on Warwick's extraordinary self-contained campus, with access to all its amazing facilities.

We have flexible teaching and learning spaces, a 24-hour library, Arts Centre and Cinema, as well as a Sports and Wellness Hub with swimming pool. Across the campus, you'll find restaurants and cafes, and many green spaces including lakes, woodland, and open fields. The campus is set in nearly 300 hectares of natural countryside, where you can relax and escape from the buzz of main campus.

You can also choose to live on campus during the three-week Summer School, to really make the most of everything that the University has to offer. If you live in one of our halls of residence, you will have swim and gym access included. We offer a range of accommodation packages to suit different tastes and budgets, from room only to half board.

Social and cultural programme

Our social and cultural programme ensures that your experience will be memorable and fun!

The social programme allows you to take a break from studying and meet your fellow students outside of the classroom. A range of these activities, events and guest lectures are included in the tuition fee, offering great value for money. The tuition fee includes:

Admissions and application

Entry requirements vary according to the course applied for, you should check our webpages for the specific requirements for your chosen course

Language Requirements

Our Summer School courses are taught in English so students must be able to demonstrate a good level of English language and comprehension. We assess students' English ability through their application and correspondence.

Visa Information

You may require immigration permission to attend the Warwick Summer School. You should only start your visa application once you have made a tuition fee payment and received an electronic visa invitation letter.

Fees

A £1,000 deposit (or full payment) will be required to secure your place on the Warwick Summer School - this deposit is included in the overall tuition fees outlined below.
