All Summer School courses are three weeks long and are suitable for students 18+, who are currently studying (or who have previously studied) at undergraduate or postgraduate level.

You will be awarded a certificate of attendance upon completion of the programme and if you sit the optional course assessment, you will also be sent an official University of Warwick transcript of results. This can usually be used for credit transfer at your home institution - in previous years, students who have successfully transferred credits for our courses have received 15 CATS/7.5 ECTS/3 US credits.
